## MPP Chudleigh is meeting with industry leaders

In an effort to identify barriers to investment and growth, Halton MPP Ted Chudleigh is scheduled to meet with representatives from various industrial groups.

"I'm trying to understand what government can do to help these key sectors of our economy," said Mr. Chudleigh, who's heading up the meetings in his position as parliamentary assistant to the minister of economic development and trade.

"If we can get ahead of the curve and make necessary changes now, we can help these companies smooth out the economic cycle. That will lead to more growth, more jobs and opportunity, and ultimately better living standards."

The meetings will form the basis of a report Mr. Chudleigh will present to Economic Development and Trade Minister Bob Runciman this fall.

Mr. Chudleigh has already met with representatives from Sarnia's chemical valley and is slated for extensive consultations throughout the summer with companies in the Toronto area and Northern Ontario.

"It's my goal to identify red tape, inter-provincial trade barriers, regulatory issues and other impediments to growth," he said.
