#### Trafalgar Road (Regional Road 3) Improvements Class Environmental Assessment Study

The Regional Municipality of Halton has initiated a Class Environmental Assessment to consider options to satisfy travel demand on Trafalgar Road from Britannia Road north to the south ramp of Highway 401 (see map below). To address operational deficiencies associated with this segment of Trafalgar Road, a number of road improvement alternatives will be examined, including widening the roadway, new road alignments, possible railway crossing and improvements to intersections, among others.

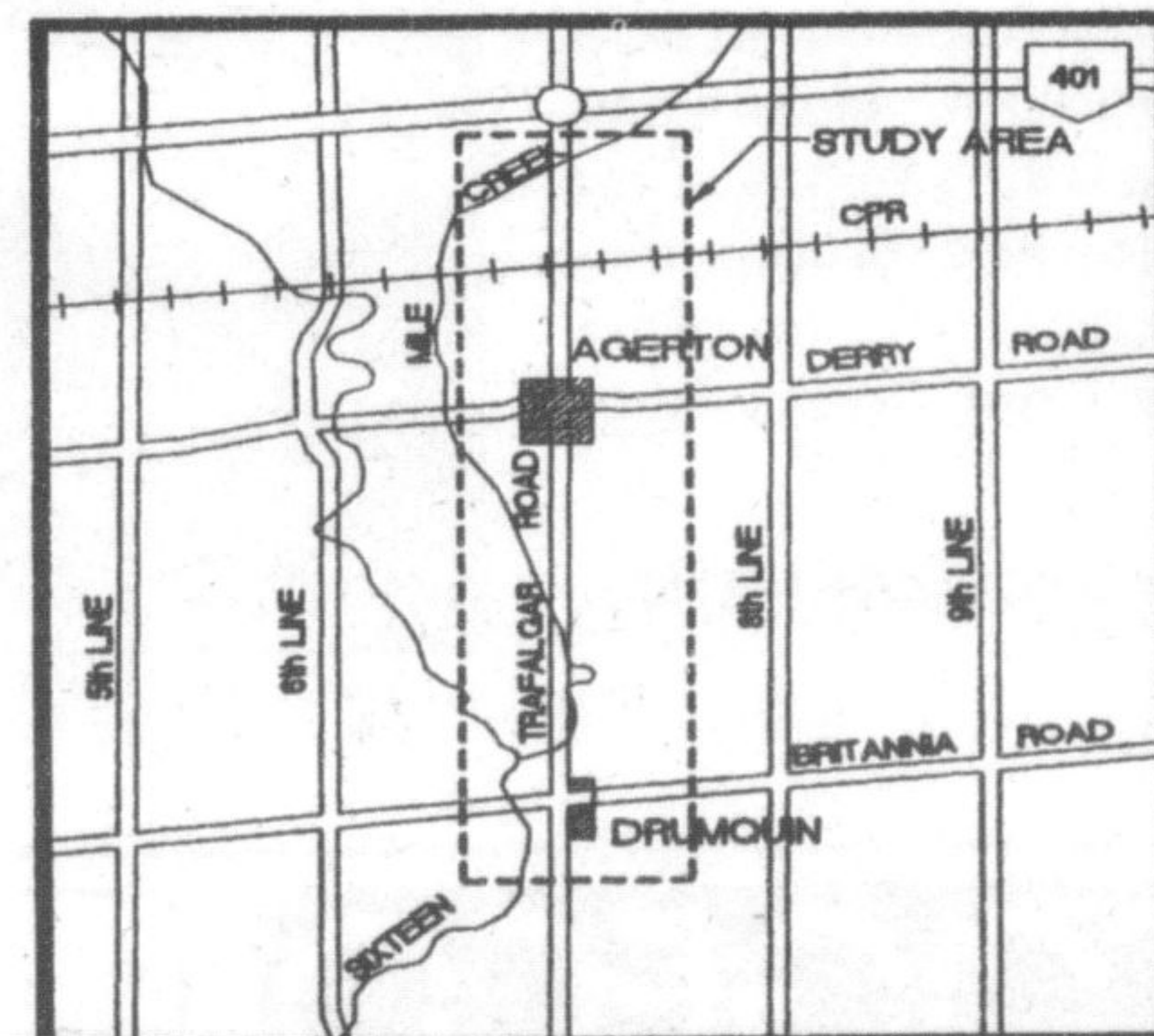
The study will be conducted in compliance with Schedule C of the Municipal Engineers Association *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* (June 2000). A Public Information Centre (PIC) is planned to provide further information to the public and interested stakeholders and to receive input and feedback on the study to date. The PIC is to be held:
