

Two men charged in equipment thefts at local construction sites

Two men were charged Monday in connection with thefts from construction sites in Halton and Peel regions.

Following an intense investigation by the Halton Regional Police's auto theft team in Milton, the suspects — described as from the Halton area — face two charges each of theft over \$5,000 and one of possession of stolen property.

Over Labour Day weekend, a 2001 Caterpillar 973 front end loader was stolen from a site at Derry Road and Fourth Line and was recovered in Snelgrove, Ont.

During the recovery of the machine, officers also located and seized a 1999 Case 90XT skid steer reported stolen in June.

The combined value of the recovered machines was \$450,000.

As part of the same investigation, other property was recovered in York region last month.

Damage was valued at \$2,000.

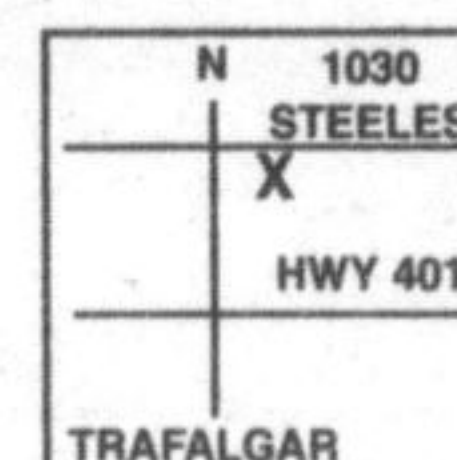
