

# Former Milton photographer selling WTC prints for charity

Former Miltonian Jag Gundu has taken many a photograph in his six years as a professional shutter bug.

But these days an image of the now leveled World Trade Centre (WTC) twin towers holds particular importance to him. And he's hoping others feel the same way.

The 29-year-old — who now lives and works in Toronto — was in New York last spring photographing an international tennis competition and in his off time ventured into the city's financial district to take a few tourist snapshots.

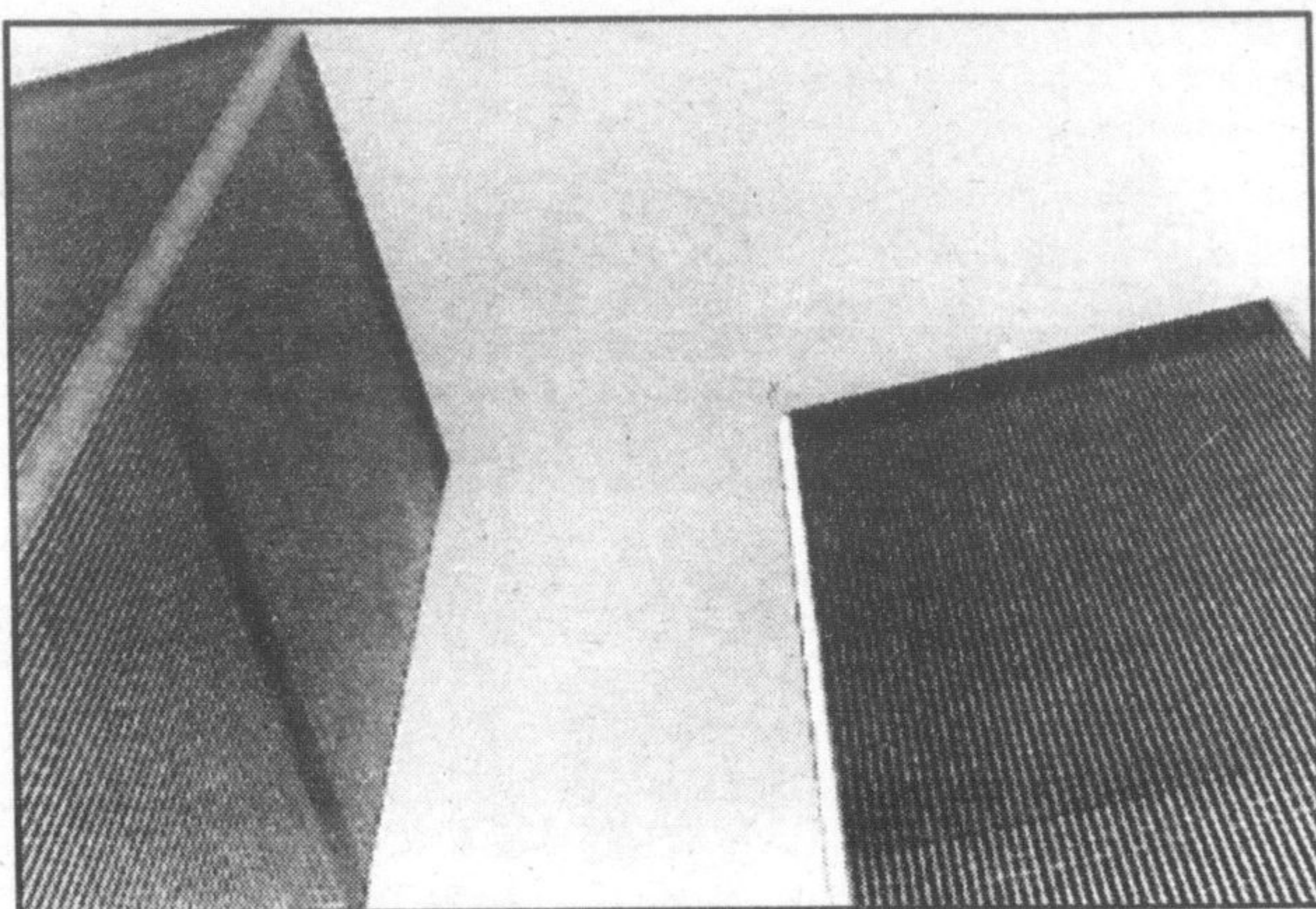
"It was phenomenal, one of those monuments you just can't miss," said Mr. Gundu of the WTC twin towers. "It's a equivalent of our CN Tower."

Deeply affected by the events of September 11, Mr. Gundu is now looking to his photography skills as a way of contributing to ongoing relief efforts.

He's offering prints of his twin towers photo for sale — which come matted and framed for \$260 — and will donate proceeds to Canadian and American charities.

"I asked myself, 'What could I do to help?' and this seemed like the best way," he explained.

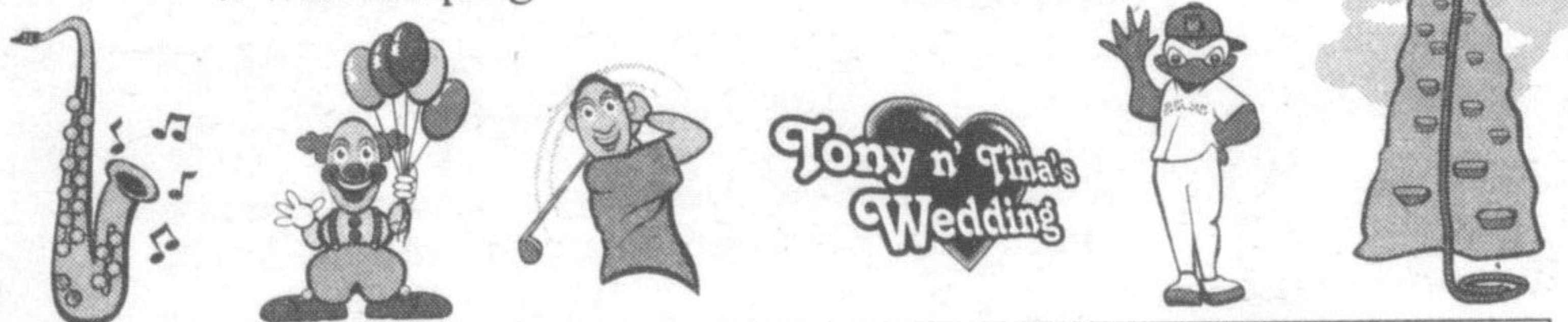

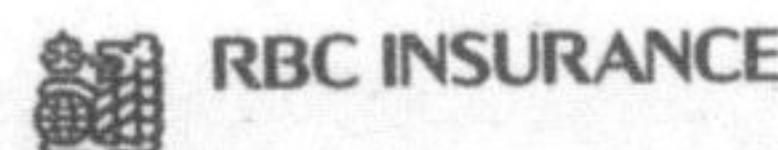
