Melaine Rego, 16, swept her advanced level age division with top honours in both kata (forms) and self defense. Mark Logan shone among adult intermediates with a first in kata and second in fighting.

The local duo were also golden a little closer to home during Etobicoke's Golden Belt Championships.

Logan finished first in adult green belt kata while Rego matched that in her blue belt age class self defense field.

Hefty hardware haul

Fighting Griffin sent six other participants to the city showcase including Tammy Hogarth, who among adult black belts was first in kata. She also struck silver in weapons and self defense.

Fellow pre-teens Rachel Ley, 9, and Samantha Walton, 10, each secured a second-place finish — in yellow belt kata and green belt, black stripe self defense respectively.

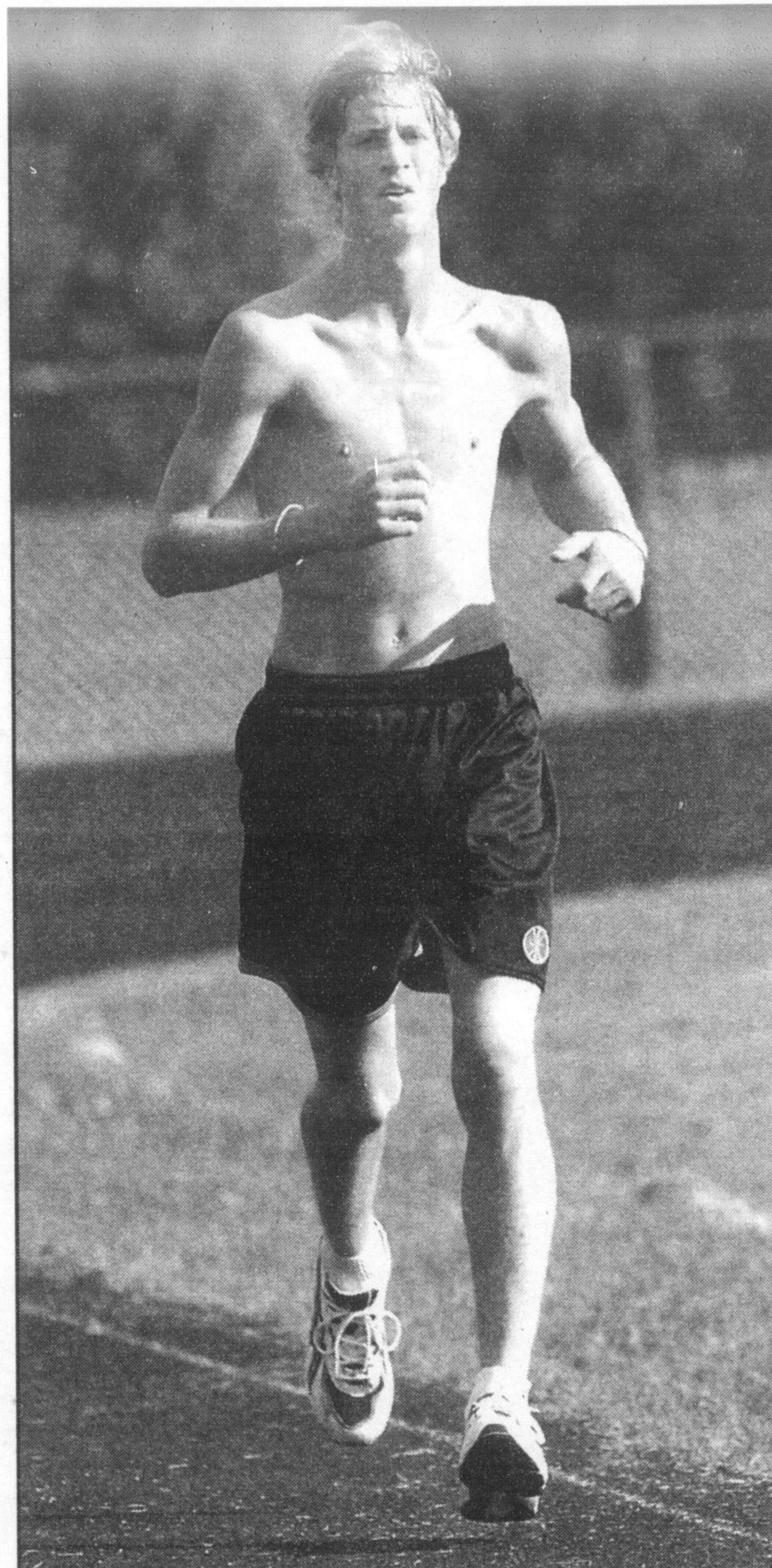

Jr. 'Stangs battle back to upstage White Oaks

Milton District High School's junior football team is all about the second half.

The Mustangs are becoming quite reliable at delivering impressive performances beyond intermission, and did so once again amid soggy conditions last Friday.

Fortifying its efforts against Oakville's White Oaks, MD rallied for its second straight comeback victory on home turf — outdistancing the Wildcats 14-7.

The win squared their season record at 2-2.

Linebacker Matt Freckleton highlighted the turnaround by intercepting the opposing quarterback — who rather foolishly threw from the end-zone — early in the fourth and returning the ball six yards for the winning major.

This followed a lengthy third-quarter drive and tying touchdown, his fourth of the year, by Ryan Wildfang. Daryl Meinen helped spearhead this possession, as did Jordan Munn.

Todd Arruda booted both extra-point kicks and contributed to a defensive unit that all but completely suffocated the visitors down the stretch.

Other standouts in this department were Greg Cole, Mark Galick and Brent McCrimmon-Jones.

The 'Stangs had a couple of golden opportunities to score in the opening half, but faltered exchanges put the kibosh on their efforts. White Oaks' lone touchdown came just seconds before half time.

MD had another big test yesterday afternoon at Burlington's Lord Elgin. Results were not available at press time. They will wrap up regular season play Wednesday at home against Oakville's St. Thomas Aquinas.
