

Halton Region opens new lots for commuters

In an effort to promote carpooling, Halton Region has announced the opening of four new commuter parking lots along Hwy. 407.

"When it comes to transportation, we have to think creatively about developing a variety of alternatives, and carpooling is a very practical option for a lot of commuters," Regional Chair Joyce Savoline said in a press release.

"Carpooling can help drivers get to and from work more easily and help ensure that our community continues to be an effective transportation link to the Greater Toronto Area."

The four lots will offer nearly 1,000 additional parking spaces available free of charge for commuters.

New locations include Hwy. 407 interchanges at Appleby Line, Bronte Road, Trafalgar Road and Dundas Street (located opposite Northhampton Boulevard).
