"It's a comedy, it's very funny," said director Susan Cranford.

"I don't want to give away too much of the play, but it's about a young man who moved from Ohio to New York and his father arrived unexpectedly at his apartment. The family has some issues they have to get aroundand they deal with it with a sense of humour. That's all I'm willing to say."

The cast members have been busy rehearsing since last month and are currently putting the finishing touches on the play.

Although Allen Fraser is making his acting debut with the Milton Players, he's no stranger to the stage, having been in several plays with the Village Theatre in Waterdown. He joins the cast as Ben Chambers, Norman's father and husband to Beatrice, Norman's mother.

Gino Raimondo is back for his seventh season with the theatre group as Garson Hobart, Norman's roommate. He was last seen in last season's production



week, two hours each time," Ms Cranford said. "After a couple of nights trying to get the blocking positions (movement of cast on stage) right, we got down to rehearsing scene by scene and working with different facial expressions."

She found it challenging to choreograph the physical activities for this particular play.

"There's a scene where the cast members are chasing each other around the apartment. It's hard to choreograph the scene so people aren't crashing into furniture and hurting themselves. Blocking is the most difficult to deal with because we're working with a very small stage. For this play we have a bedroom and living room. Moving the characters around the stage is always challenging because you want them out where the audience can see them, not hiding in the back. Once all the blocking is figured out, then we can have fun."

Ms Cranford's favourite part of

"Once everyone has learned their lines, it's putting the little touches at the end that's fun, like seeing what it's like saying a line this way instead of that."
