Participants achieve the award by attaining personally established goals in the areas of community service, skills development, physical fitness and expeditions.

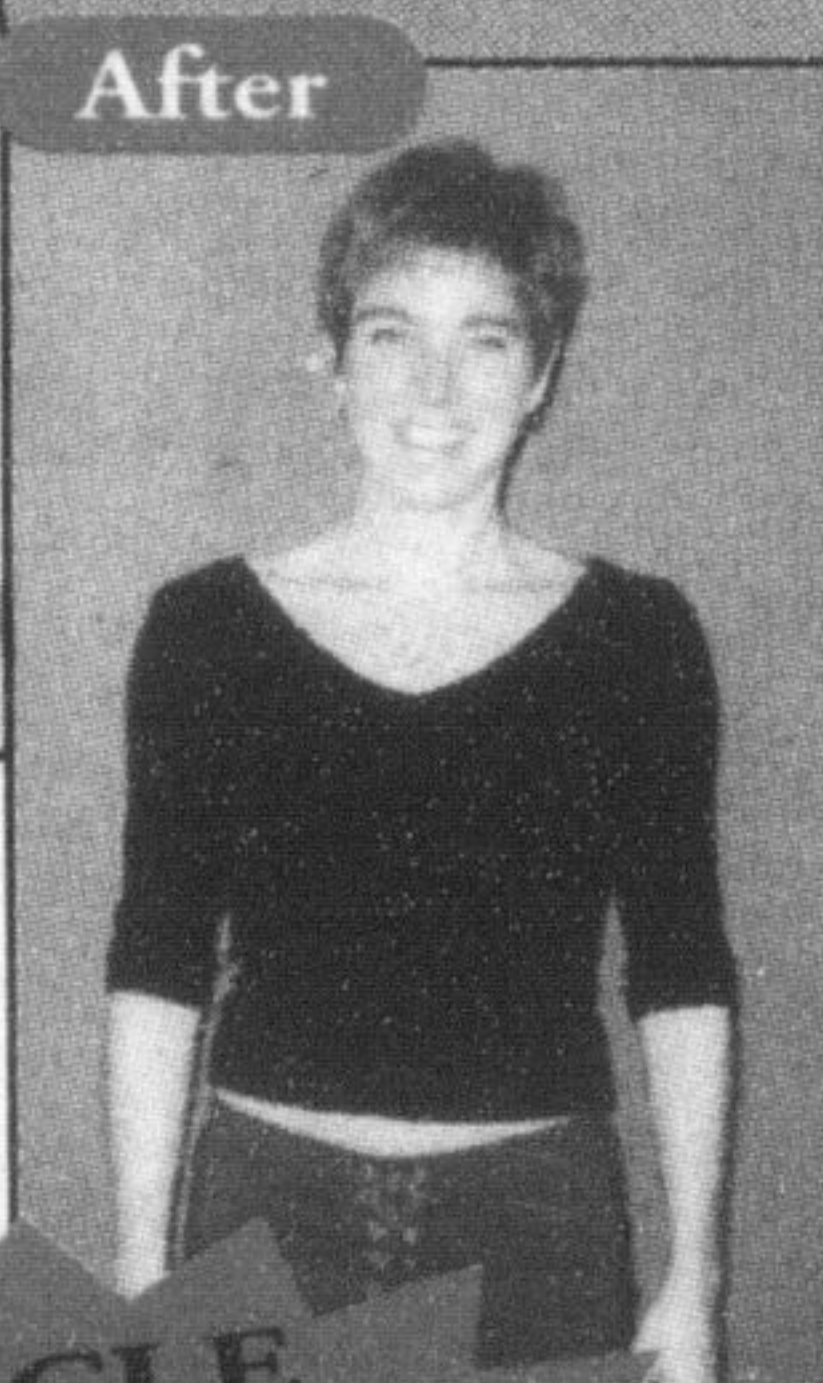
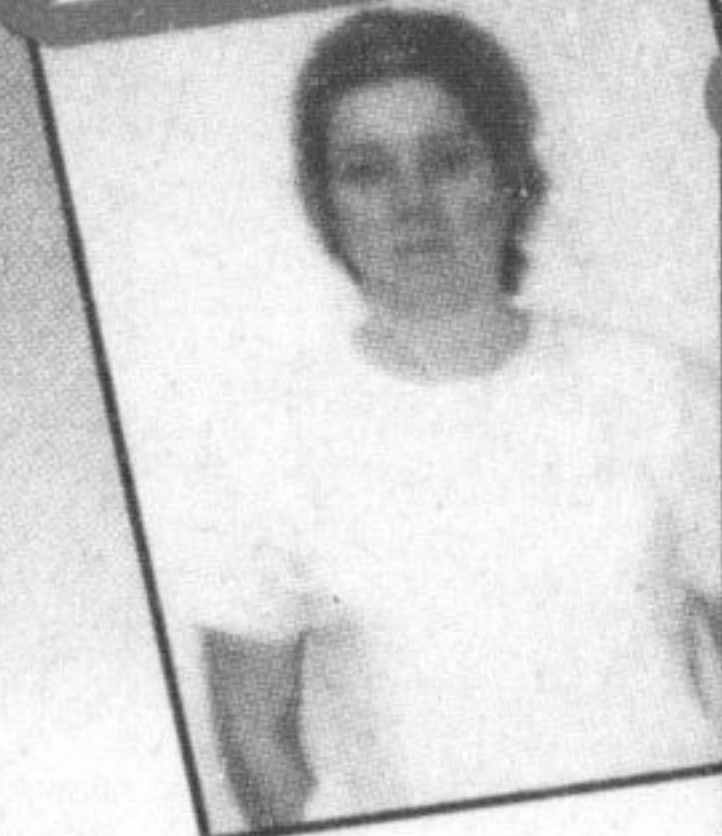

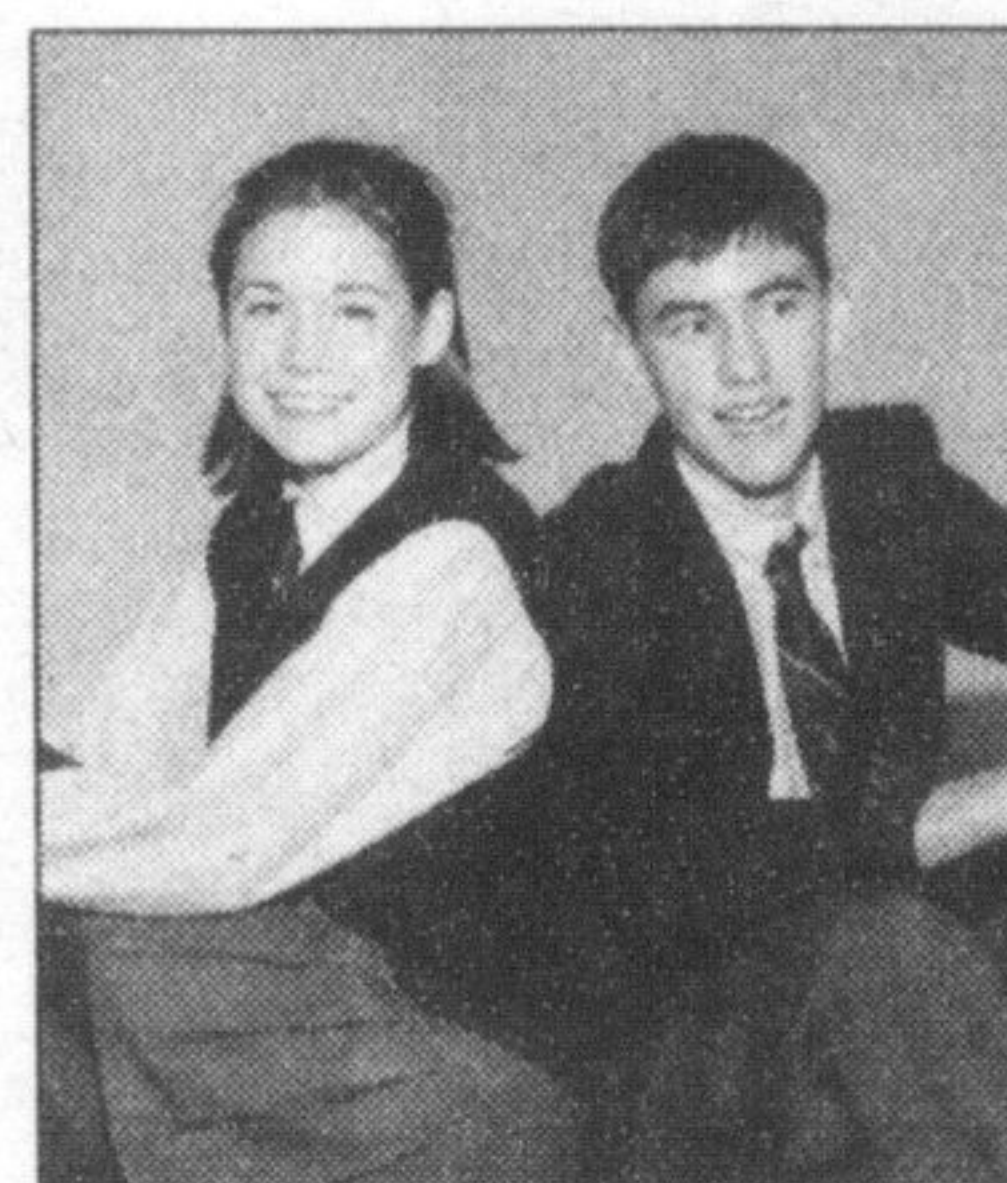
