



Time to remember

NOTICE DOWNTOWN PARKING LOT RECONSTRUCTION

The Town of Milton will begin reconstruction of various parking lots located in Downtown Milton. In general, this reconstruction work involves removal of asphalt, drainage improvements, installation of new asphalt and parking stall markings. During this work period, the designated parking lots will be completely closed off to allow crews to complete this work as quickly as possible.

Where possible, the work will be done in phases to reduce inconvenience to downtown residents, business owners and their customers.


First Phase: The Mill Street parking lot, will be closed from November 8 to November 16, 2001. Alternative parking can be accommodated in the Mary Street parking lot, CIBC Bank Machine parking lot at Main and Brown Streets and Town Hall parking lot on Mary Street.

Second Phase: The Mary Street parking lot will be closed from November 15, 2001 to November 22, 2001. Alternative parking will be available in the Mill Street parking lot, CIBC Bank Machine parking lot at Main and Brown Streets and Town Hall parking lot on Mary Street.

The above dates are subject to weather conditions.

During both of these periods, no overnight parking will be permitted within the parking lots under reconstruction.

2 AM to 7 AM Nov. 15 to April 15 By-Law 1984-1

ROAD RECONSTRUCTION AND WATERMAIN & WASTEWATERMAIN REPLACEMENT

Mountainview Drive from Ontario Street to Highside Drive and Elm Avenue from Highside Drive to Woodward Avenue

The Town of Milton and the Region of Halton will be, through a joint effort, reconstructing Mountainview Drive from Highside Drive to Ontario Street and Elm Avenue from Highside Drive to Woodward Avenue. The work will include the installation of sidewalks, curbs, storm sewer, asphalt road surface, and replacing the existing watermain and wastewater main.

A Public Information Centre is being held to provide the public with an opportunity to review project drawings and to discuss any potential construction disruptions from the proposed works. Town of Milton, Region of Halton staff, and the engineering consultant, will be present to answer questions.
