Hospital foundation looks to raise \$180,000 for mammography unit

Current mammography machine used at Milton hospital too old

To help women receive the best care for detecting breast cancer, the Milton District Hospital Foundation is embarking on a campaign to raise funds to purchase a new mammography machine.

"The current machine at Milton District Hospital is a little dated," said Kim Mason, hospital foundation board member and chair of the mammography fundraising campaign. "(A mammography machine) is an essential piece of equipment for the early detection of breast cancer."

Milton District Hospital (MDH) performs 1,600 mammography examinations each year. Currently, the hospital's ability to provide this service - at the highest level of quality — is being reduced as a result of the age of the current mammography unit, which is nearing the 10-year mark.

While the machine now used at MDH is still in working condition, it's not compatible with some of the newer breast can-

cer screening technologies. With new equipment, MDH will be able to provide clearer, more accurate mammography results.

The new mammography unit will cost \$180,000. A state-ofthe-art General Electric model has already been carefully selected, Ms Mason said.

"We're looking to the town for support," she said, adding the hospital foundation has sent out letters to homes and corporations in town asking for donations. "We're trying to raise awareness of the need for a new unit in Milton."

The first donation was made by the Royal Bank in the amount of \$9,500, she said.

"In May we're having a gala at Rattlesnake Point (Golf Club) which we hope will be the final fundraising event. We hope to have the new mammography machine in Milton by May at the latest."

A mammography is an X-ray of the breast. It can be used to determine if a lump is a gland, cyst or a tumour and is also used in the detection of breast cancer.

Milton District Hospital Foundation is an independent, registered charity founded in

1980 for the purpose of raising funds for MDH and the purchase of urgently-needed medical equipment.

Milton Residents: YARD WASTE COLLECTION ENDS THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 26th, 2001!

Place materials curbside by 7:30 a.m.

 Please keep Yard Waste separate from your garbage and blue box. This avoids confusion during collection.

 Yard Waste <u>must</u> be placed in <u>clear</u> plastic bags (dark bags will \ not be collected), large paper yard waste bags or small open containers (no garbage cans).

Brush must be bundled and tied, not bagged, no larger than 4 feet long by 2 feet diameter with branches a maximum of 3 inches diameter.

Yard Waste bags or containers must be no heavier than 23 kg (50 pounds).

Grasscycle by leaving grass clippings on your lawn as mulch!

Composting (backyard or vermicomposting) can divert up to 25% of waste going to landfill.
