

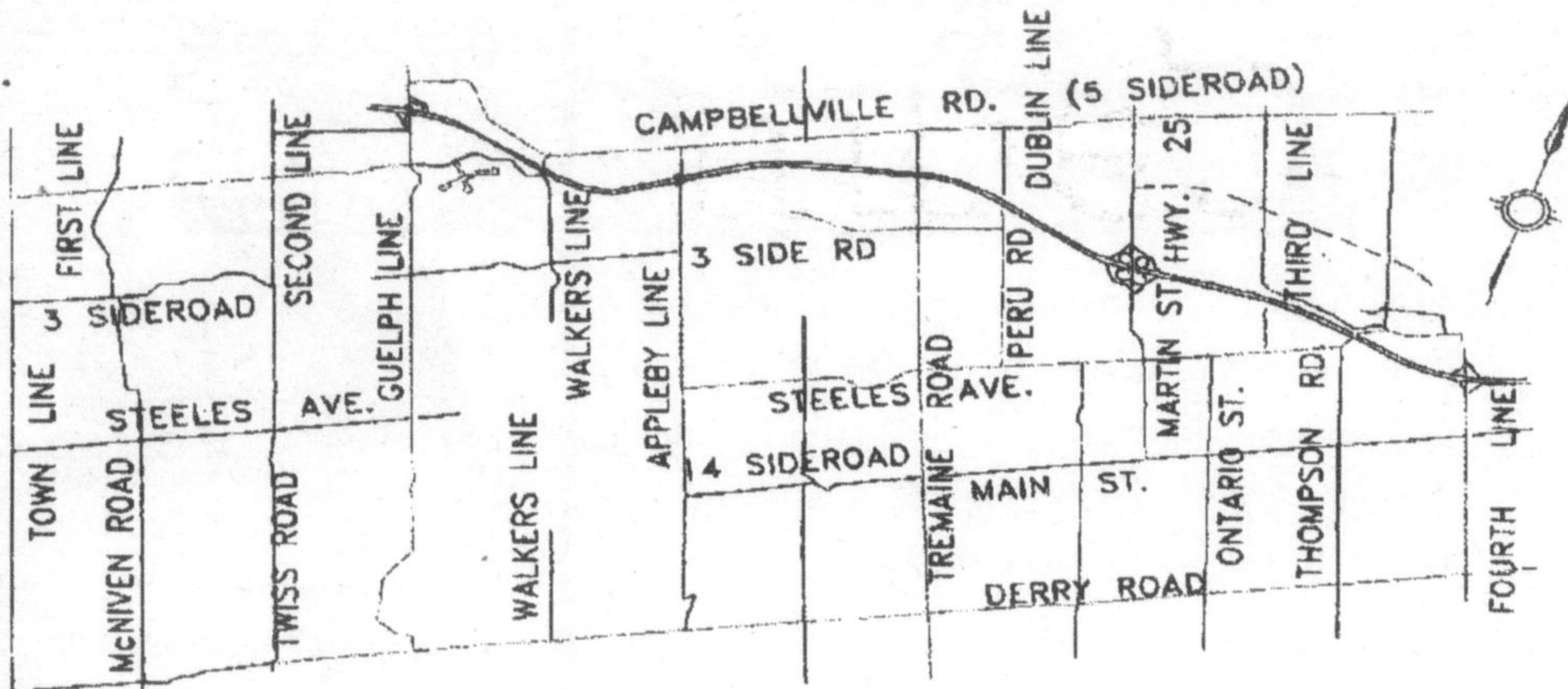

A bartender noticed a window screen was cut in the storage room, next to the adjoining bar.

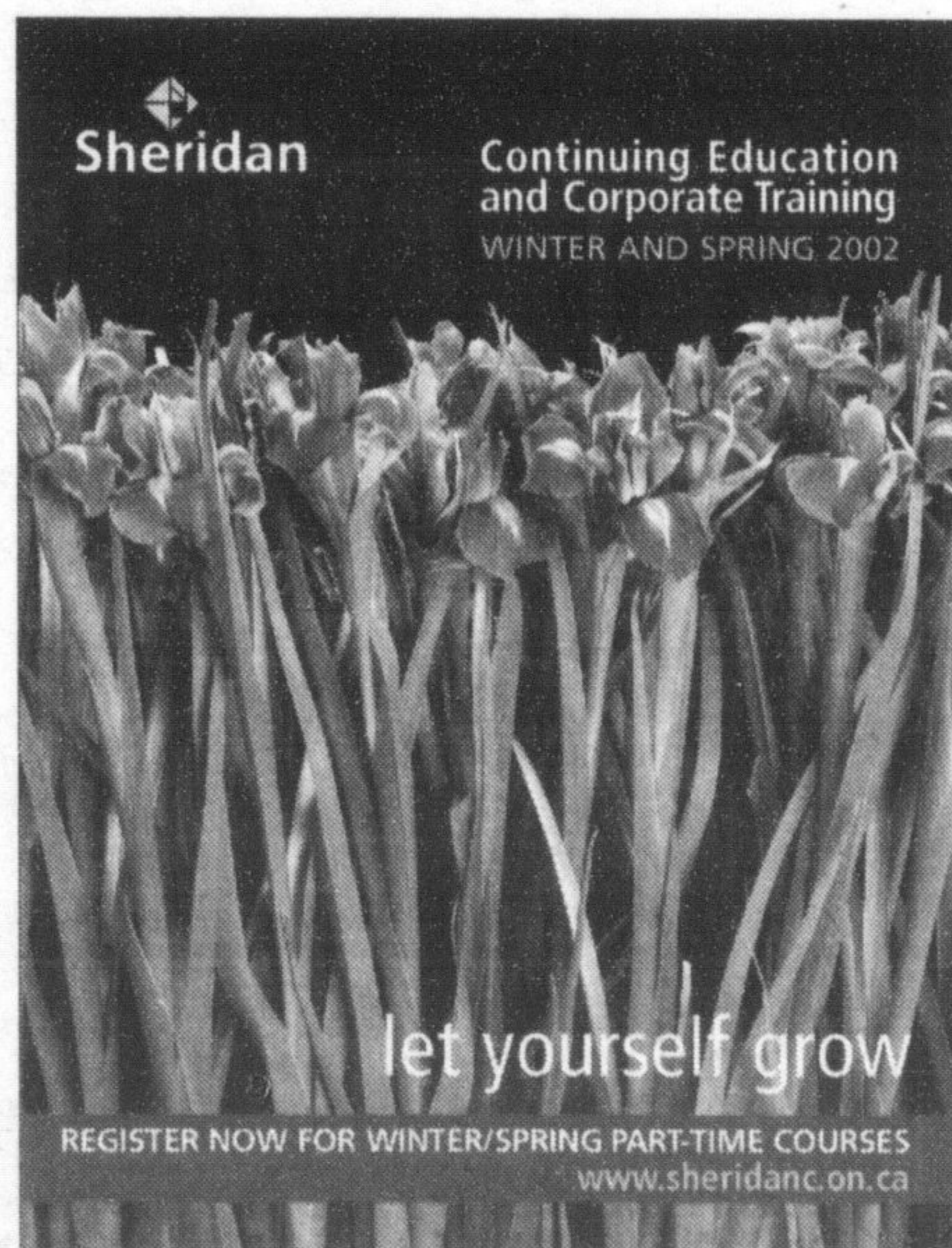

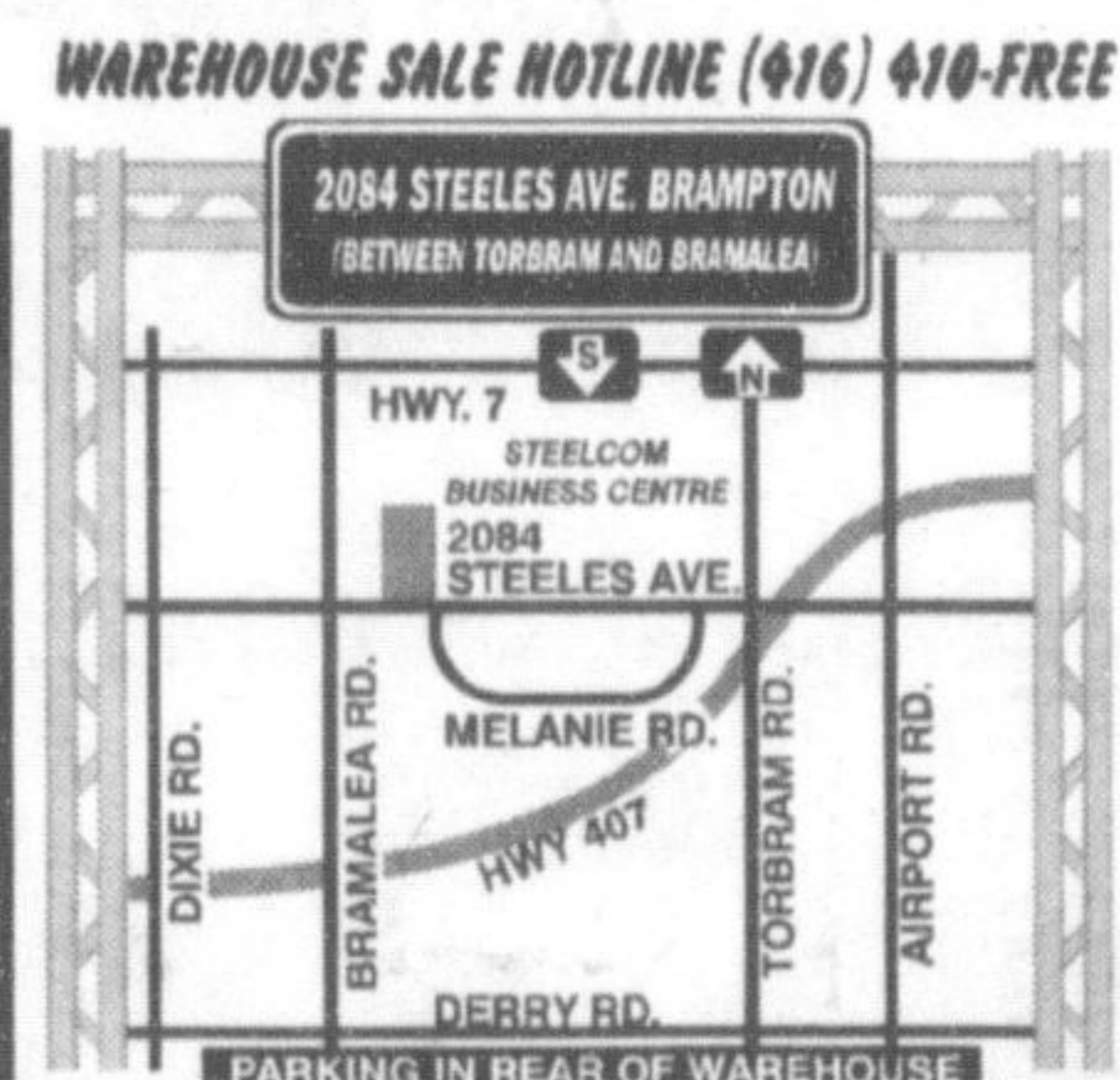
