# Food bank gets lots of donations but contributions to Salvation Army kettles are substantially down

If cash donations don't start picking up this week, the Salvation Army's Christmas Kettle Campaign might be in hot water.

As of Thursday, \$7,000 had been collected — \$21,000 short of its goal.

Last year, \$26,000 was raised through the campaign.

"It's been very slow — this is not usual," said Laurie Good, family service worker for the Milton branch of the Salvation Army.

"The cause could be anything. We've had a hard time getting volunteers to stand on the kettles. Maybe people have donated to someplace else. Maybe a lot of people sent money to New

York after the terrorist attacks, maybe that's why donations are so down."

A similar situation has been reported in other areas, like Oakville, where kettle donations are also way down.

In Milton, the kettles are set up at Loblaws, Milton Mall and the beer and liquor stores.

"I believe it will all work out in the end. This close to Christmas the donations should really

start to come in."

Although the monetary side of donations may be down, food donations are on the rise.

So far, about nine tonnes of food has been donated to the local Salvation Army branch, which should bring smiles to the faces of 130 families registered for the food bank.

"We just seem to be slow in cash right now," Ms Good said.
