

Man found dead in cell Saturday at Maplehurst

Halton Regional Police are investigating the death of an Oakville man at Maplehurst Detention Centre over the weekend.

Viet Haun Nguyen, 57, was found without vital signs in his cell Saturday morning and was transported to Hamilton General Hospital.

According to police, no suspicious circumstances were identified at the scene

and autopsy results are inconclusive at this time.

Toxicology test results were pending as of press time yesterday.

The deceased had a previous medical condition, which he received treatment for during his incarceration.

As with all institution deaths, an inquest will be held.

High winds cause power outages at many homes

Heavy winds and downed tree limbs caused several power outages across Milton Friday.

"It was mainly due to trees coming over the lines from the gusty winds," explained Milton Hydro vice-president of operations Richard Murray.

"It started at about noon and we had it

cleaned up by about 4 p.m."

During that time, three incidents were recorded, each of which saw 30 residences or less left without power.

About 300 north Milton residences were also left without hydro for a short time Friday due to a supply problem with Hydro One, Mr. Murray added.
