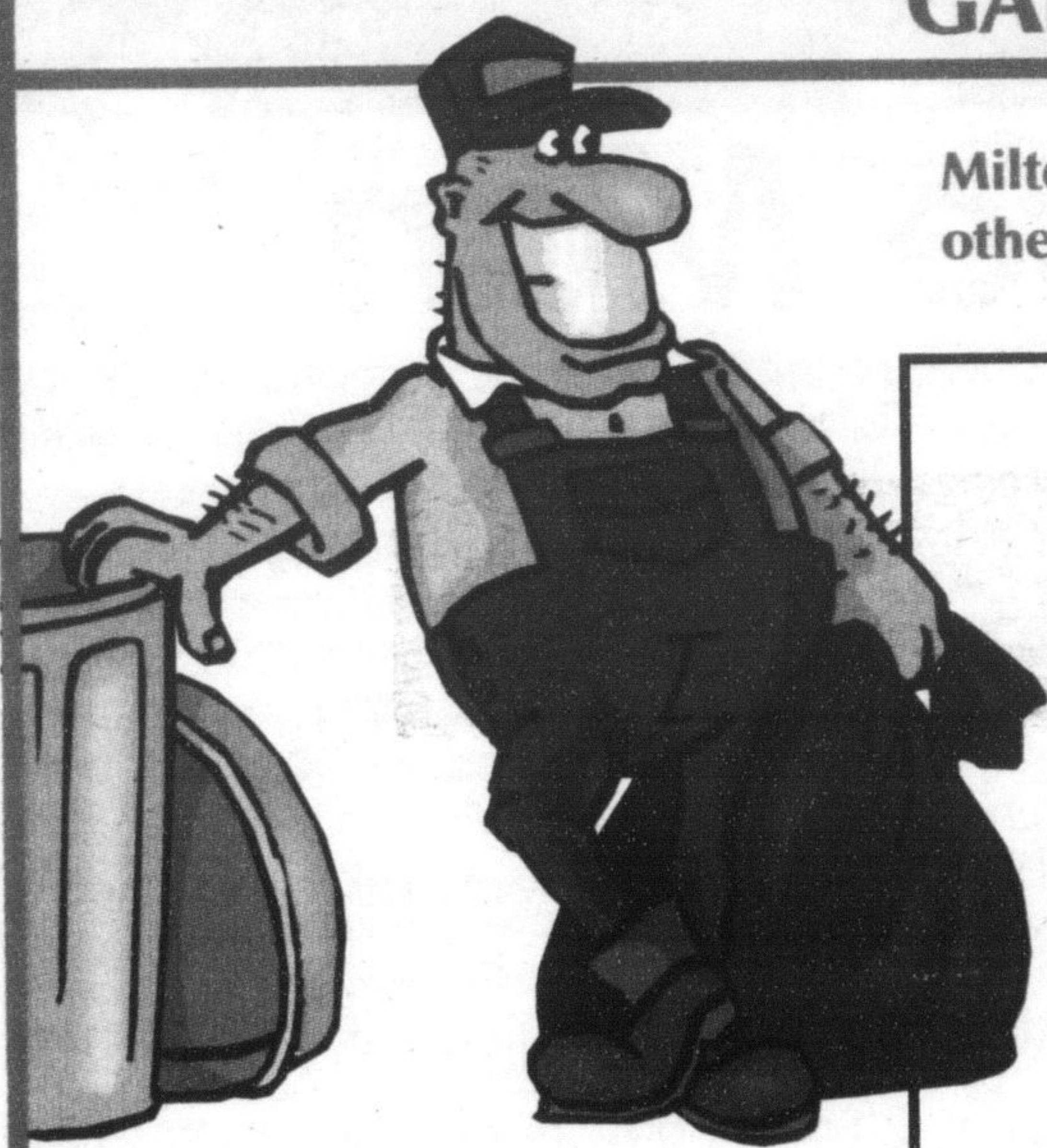

GARBAGE DAY HAS CHANGED IN MILTON!

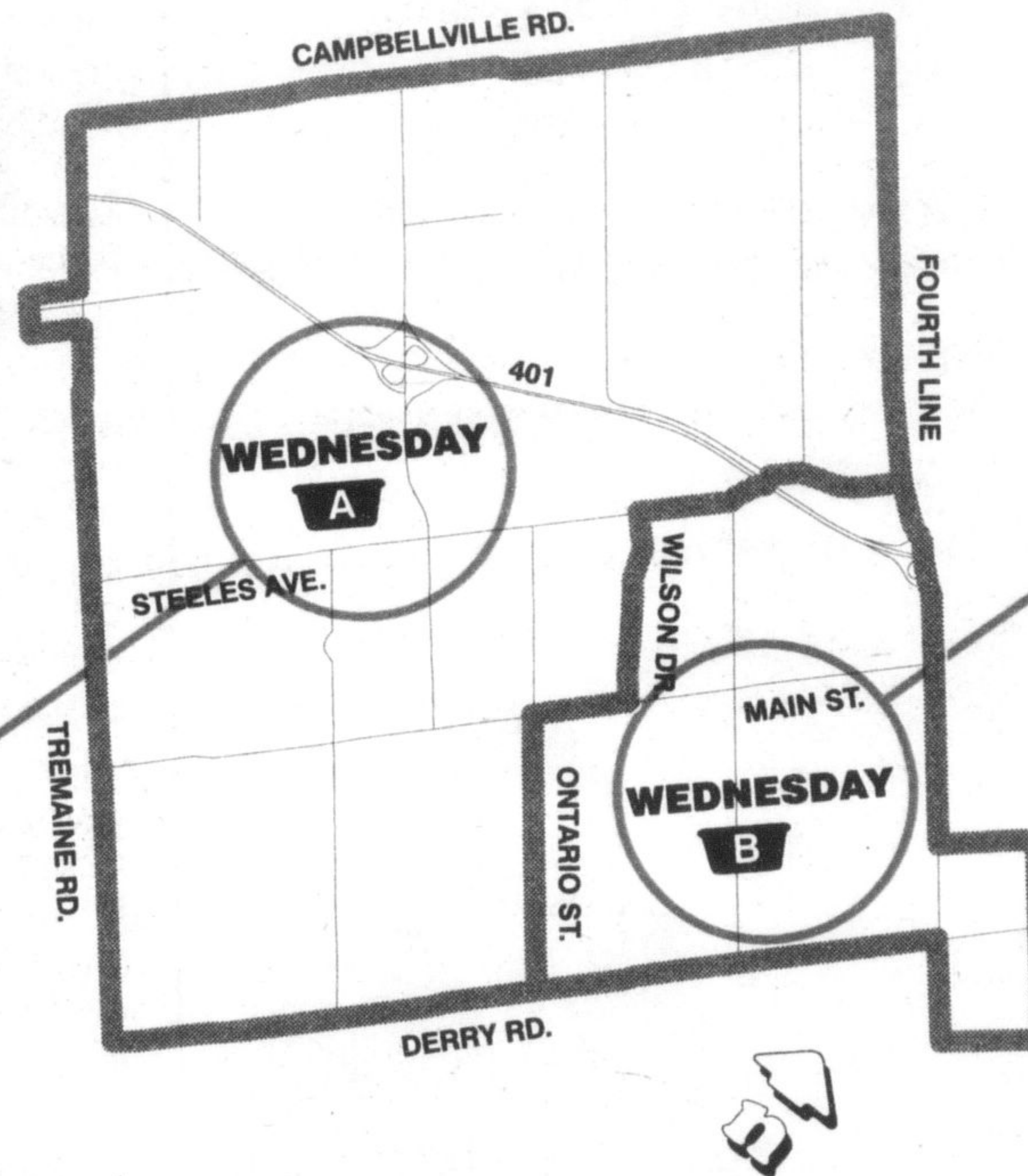
Milton household garbage will now be collected **each week** on Wednesday. Blue box material is collected **every other week** on the same day as your garbage.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE No. 2

Derry Road (Regional Road 7) Improvements Class Environmental Assessment Study

The Regional Municipality of Halton has initiated a Class Environmental Assessment to consider options to satisfy travel demand on Derry Road from First Line easterly to 150m east of Fifth Line (see map of the study area). A Public Open House was held on October 18, 2001 at which time the need for improvements was summarized, and planning alternatives were assessed. Based on input provided from stakeholders, technical agencies and public participants, as well as on an assessment by the study team, the Region has determined that the preferred solution is the widening of Derry Road from two lanes to four lanes.

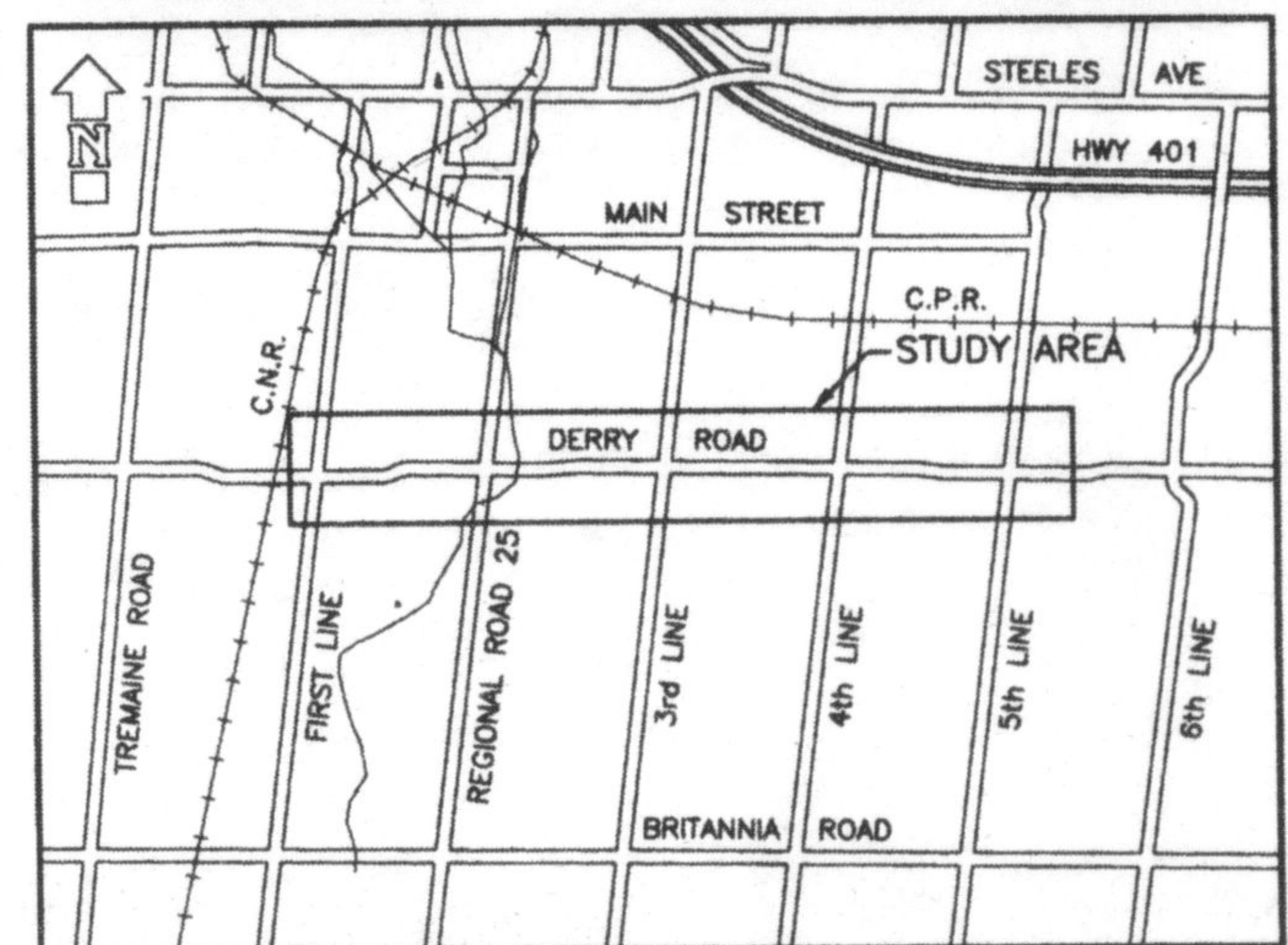
The study team is currently conducting an in-depth review of environmental conditions and is developing and assessing various detailed design alternatives. The study is being conducted in compliance with Schedule "C" of the Municipal Engineers Association "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment", (June 2000).

A Public Information Centre (PIC) is planned to provide further information to the public and to receive input and feedback on the study to date. The PIC is to be held as follows:

Those attending the PIC will have an opportunity to review the study progress and discuss the issues related to the project, including alternative designs and their effect on property and environmental considerations.
