



Waples and Bettors Delight earn coveted O'Brien titles


Milton standardbred racers took centre stage as winners at the 2001 O'Brien Awards Saturday night at Mississauga's Delta Meadowlands Hotel.

Millionaire pacing colt Bettors Delight grabbed the lion's share of the spotlight as Canada's Horse of the Year — an honour bestowed on a now retired star following an outstanding season, which included victories in the \$1 million North America Cup, the coveted Little Brown Jug and the Tattersalls Pace.

Owned by Hornby's John Grant, Bettors Delight banked a total of \$1.7 million and won most of his encounters with chief nemesis and fellow heavyweight pacer Real Desire.

Bettors Delight was also named the top three-yearold colt.

Meanwhile, Randy Waples edged out fellow Miltonian Chris Christoforou for Canadian Driver of the Year.
