

 from AWARDS on page 1 began three years ago. In July, a 5,200square-foot addition was added to the south end of the home, bringing the total square footage of the home to 9,500.

Carla and Luciano Biasutti and Frank and Robin Loconte took home the Infill Development Awards.

After owning their one-and-a-half storey cottage on Bruce Street for 12 years, Mr. and Ms Biasutti demolished the property and replaced it with a twostorey, Victorian-style Williamsburg brick home, which was completed last November.

Mr. and Ms Loconte tore down a 15foot barn on Mill Street and built a twostorey, Victoria-style country home. The 2,800-square-foot home was completed in September.

The award for Restoration of a Building Designated under the Ontario Heritage Act went to the Halton County

Radial Railway, Streetcar and Electric Railway Museum.

The Rockwood Railway Station was built in 1912 and moved to the site of the Ontario Electric Railway Museum in 1972. It was later designated as a heritage structure under the Ontario Heritage Act in 1995. Two years later, volunteers began the tedious task of removing the gray brick exterior and replaced it with its original shell of board and batten in an Indian red shade.

The Heritage Awards were co-sponsored by the Milton Historical Society the Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee (LACAC).

The Milton Historical Society requests nominations from the public every year for projects completed in the fields of writing, visual arts and education. Then the organization votes on the nominations and selects the winners. This was the 15th annual event.


