

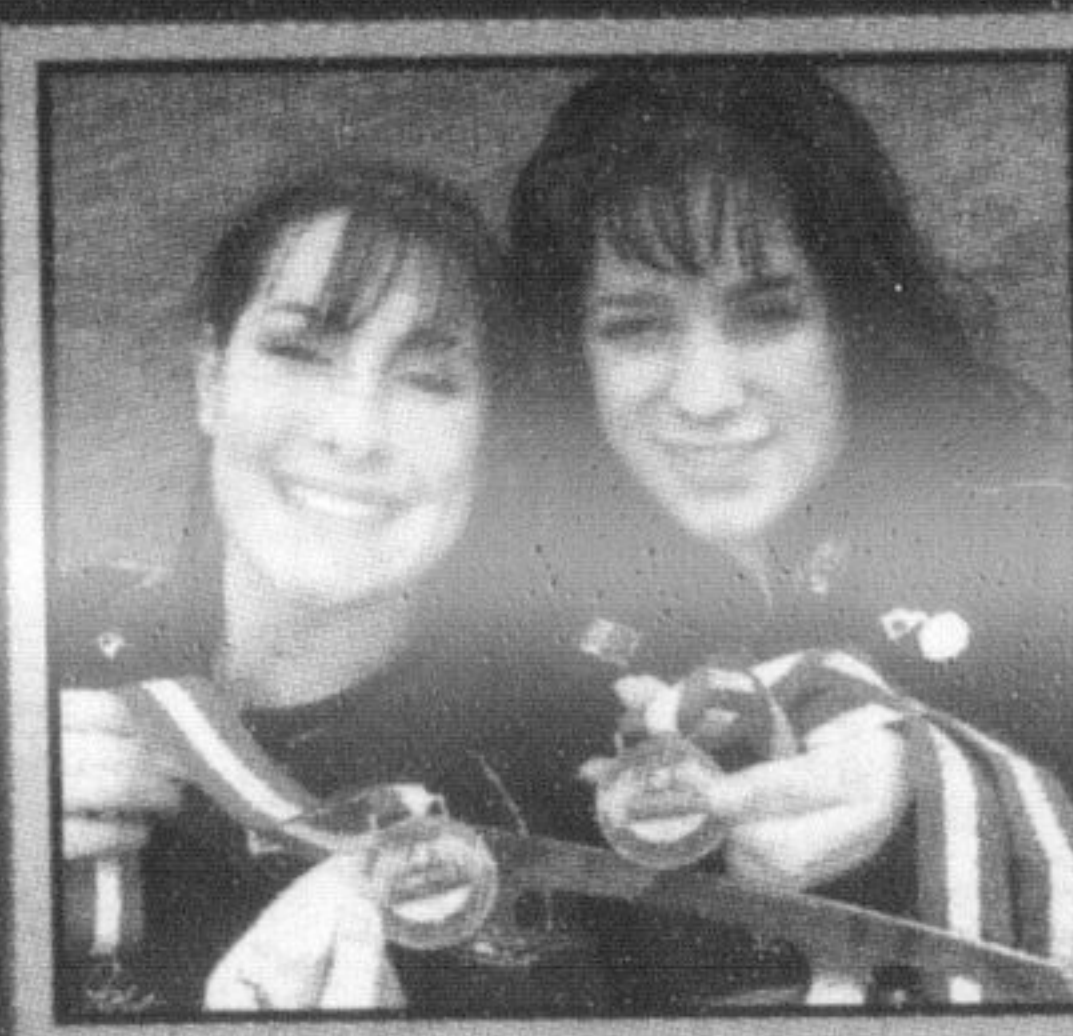

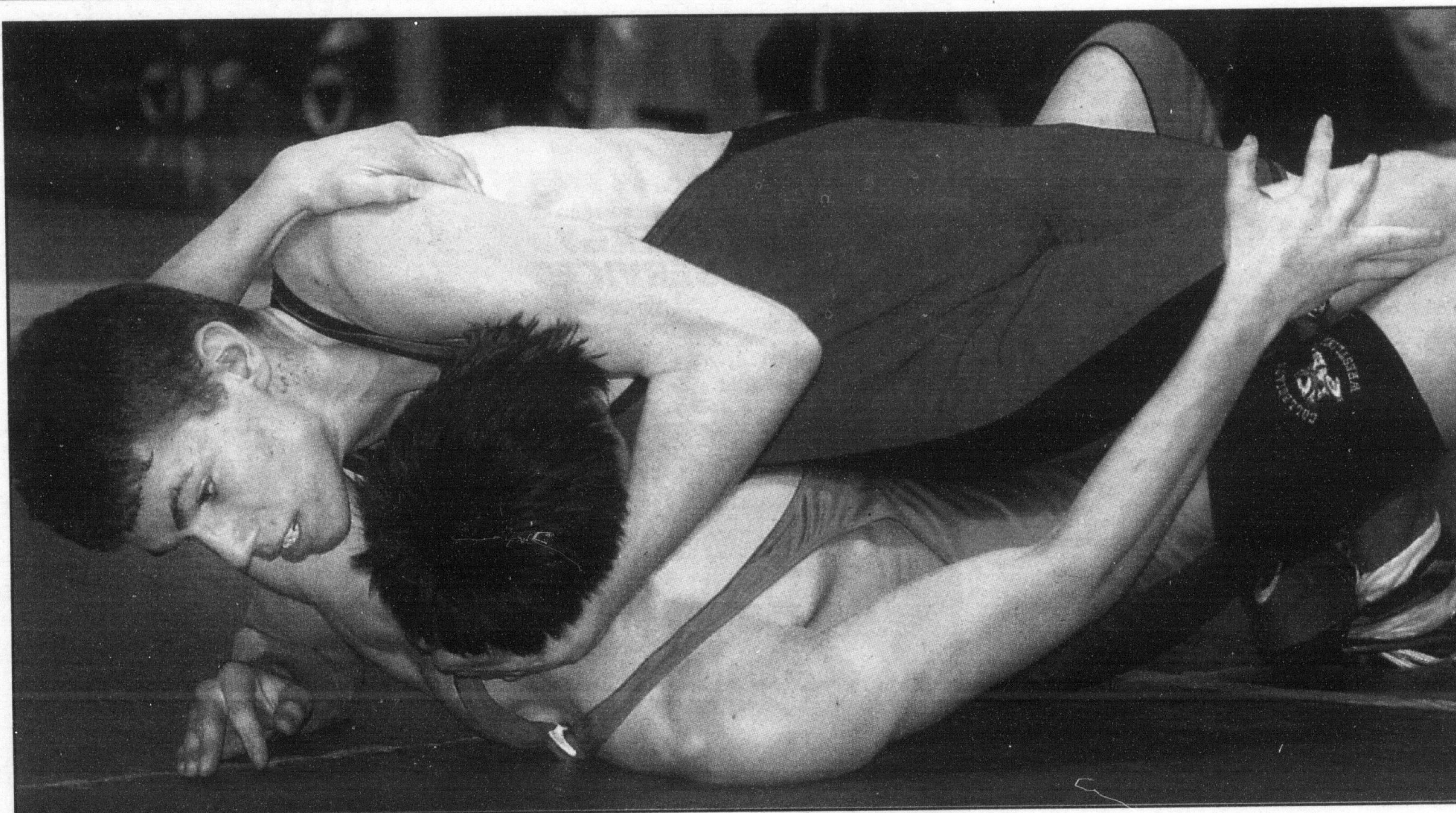

## Hit-and-run driver pleads guilty

A Brampton man charged in the hit-and-run death of Etobicoke cyclist Jacek Wierzbicki has pleaded guilty to dangerous driving causing death and failing to remain at the scene of an accident.

Paul Carroll appeared in Ontario court (provincial division) in Milton Thursday.

Mr. Wierzbicki, 41, was struck by a car travelling southbound on Tremaine Road, just north of Derry Road around 11:50 a.m. August 14. He was pronounced dead at the scene.

Mr. Carroll will be sentenced May 13 in Milton court.

A conviction of dangerous driving causing death carries a maximum sentence of 14 years in prison. Failing to remain at the scene of an accident carries a jail sentence of 10 years to life.

Since his arrest in August, Mr. Carroll has been out on \$75,000 bail.

Crown attorney Mary Ward was unavailable for comment.

## High winds topple trees, bring down hydro lines

Heavy winds downed trees, blew over construction materials and caused power outages throughout Milton Saturday night.

The snowy wind snapped five consecutive hydro

poles on Regional Road 25, north of Hwy. 401, leaving the High Point Drive industrial area and numerous residences without power.

Electricity was restored to the area by 2:30 a.m.

Sunday, with the exception of three businesses just north of Hwy. 401 which went powerless until 9 p.m.

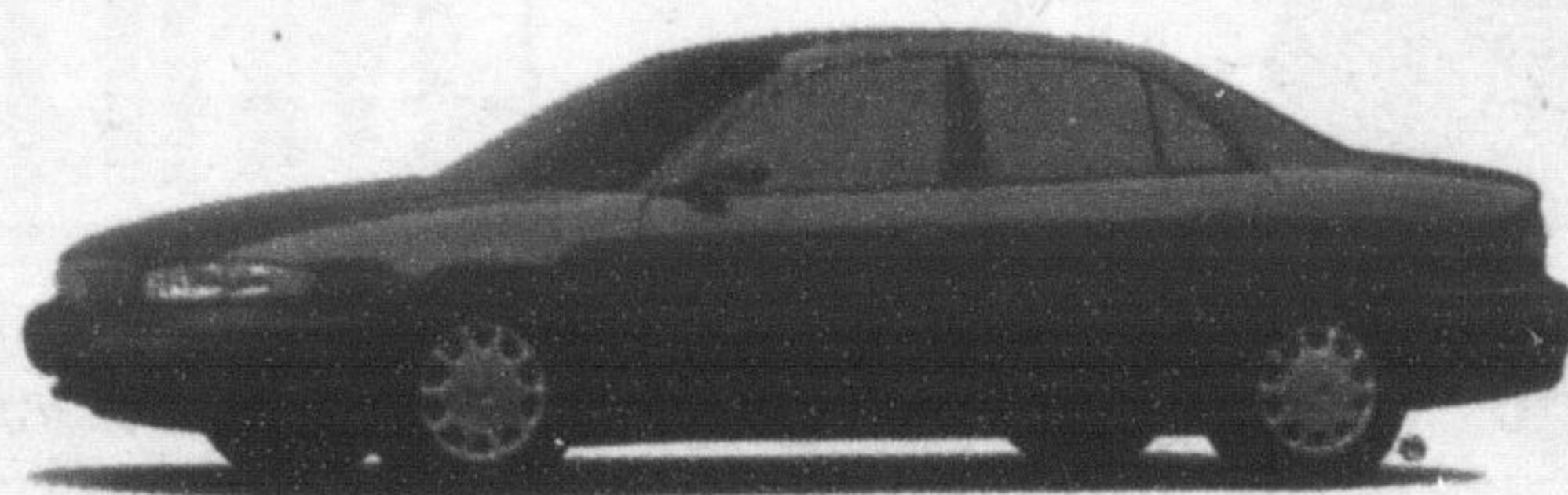
