"We hope the people of North Halton will once again be generous in their support this year during our Daffodil Month" says John Perrott, President of the Milton Branch. Last year, almost \$10 million was raised across Ontario through the residential canvass.

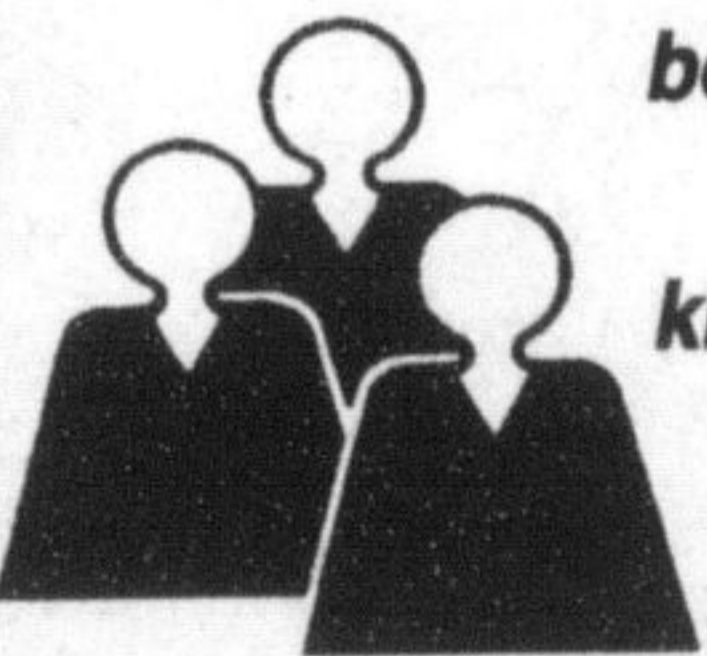

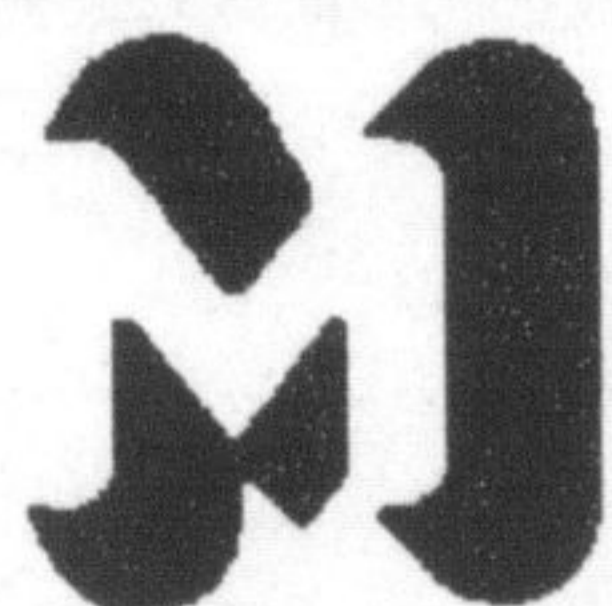

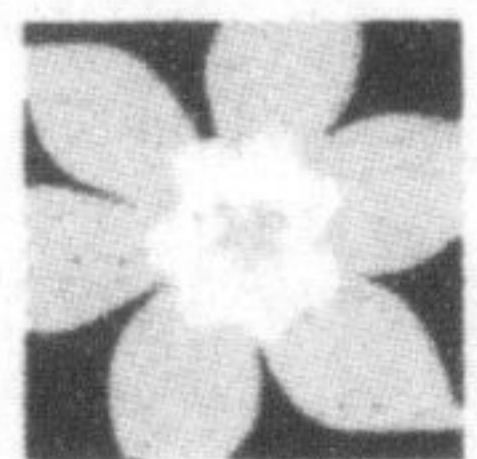
