"A lady came by Tuesday and she had her walker. They (construction workers) stopped everything (sidewalk removal and replacement) and let that lady come in. And when she went out, they stopped everything to let her

out and made sure she was okay. thought it was so nice, so polite."

Merchants have also expressed satisfaction with the way in which the construction is taking place leaving store access open at all times.

"They're not even leaving big messes around or anything. We're quite impressed," commented JoAnne McCann, co-owner of Jo'leen's Clothing for Women.
