Women of Note ... A noteworthy group

The Women of Note, a seven-member vocal ensemble, has been delighting audiences in and around Milton with its musical stylings since September 1996. The group began as an experiment by Milton singing teacher Laura Jeffrey, who specializes in working with adult singers. "I was teaching several of the women and I started to wonder how they would sound singing together," says Ms. Jeffrey. "After our first rehearsal, I knew we had something very unique!"

The Women of Note perform a Christmas and spring concert each season with repertoire that includes classical and sacred music, folk songs, Broadway show tunes, music by Canadian composers and madrigals as well as pop and jazz standards. "At our concerts, we always try to use guest artists drawn from the pool of extraordinary talent living in and around Milton," says Ms. Jeffrey. "Our concerts have

showcased wonderful veteran performers as well as gifted young musicians."

The Women of Note also sing for groups and organizations at business meetings, social gatherings and fund-raising events. The group has entertained at the Retired Teachers of Ontario Fall Senate 2000, Sky High Balloon Festival, Milton Horticultural Society, North Halton Literacy Guild, St. David's Presbyterian Church and Milton Millennium Community Residences. An annual favourite of the group is "Tunes 'n' Tales," a benefit concert for IDEA Burlington featuring music by Women of Note and stories by gifted story teller Marina Lloyd.

The singers of The Women of Note come from all walks of life, but have one thing in common — they love to sing!

Their music is greatly enhanced by the accompaniment of talented pianist, Dawn Brodie. Director Laura Jeffrey is a veteran of many choirs including The Milton Choristers, The University of Guelph Chorale, The Whiteoaks Choral Society, and the Orpheus Choir of Toronto. She has performed as a soloist in Milton, Toronto, Mississauga, Hamilton, Oakville and Guelph, and has been teaching singing in Milton since 1990.

If you haven't had the chance to see this group perform yet, mark their next performance in early June on your calendar as a must-see event (see calendar below). The Milton community is fortunate to have a vocal ensemble of this calibre in our midst and you will be charmed by their talent and warmth at this upcoming performance.
