Each day I look to see if they're back, but no luck so far. It looks as if Meg and me weren't meant to be.

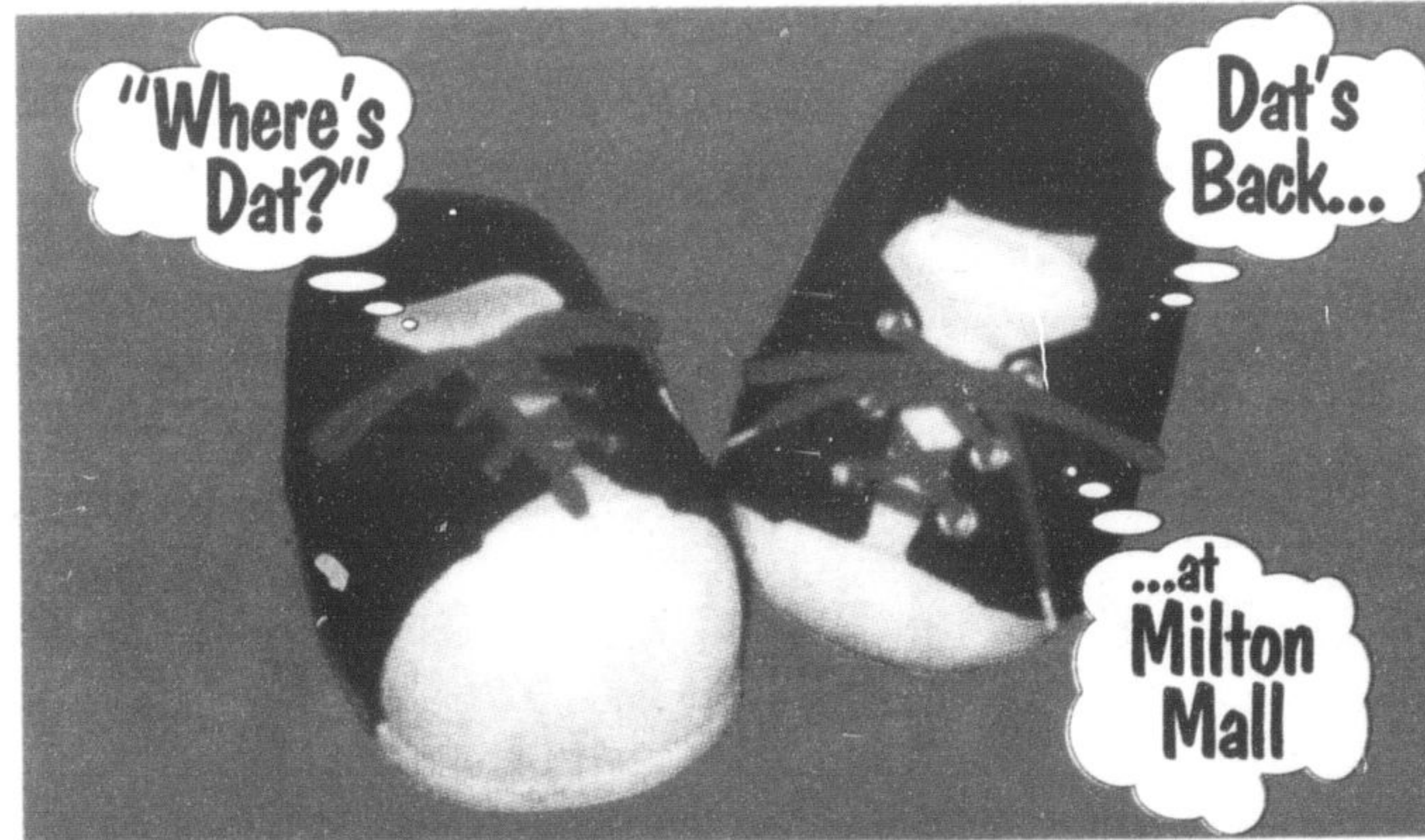
# Students can vote

The Halton District School Board's appointed student trustees now have the right to vote — it just won't count.

A proposal from Nelson High School's Brian Stanlake and Aldershot's Mark Graham to amend board bylaws to allow those in their position to vote on issues at the board table, was unanimously accepted by elected trustees at a recent meeting.

However, the student trustees' votes will not be tabulated in the final tally of the acceptance or rejection of board motions. It's still a significant step, according to trustees.

"This is an important decision because it means they will have to really think critically about the issues," said Milton trustee Erica Andrew.

Medical esthetics have also been rising in popularity. Injection treatments of Botox or Collagen to remove wrinkles have been on the rise, the doctor continued.

"It (Collagen) gets re-absorbed after a while. After about eight weeks it'll go away. It's not a permanent thing," Dr. Assad said when asked for a reason behind the popularity.


"And it's an office procedure. You can

In terms of facelift surgery, there doesn't seem to be much of a demand at this point in time.

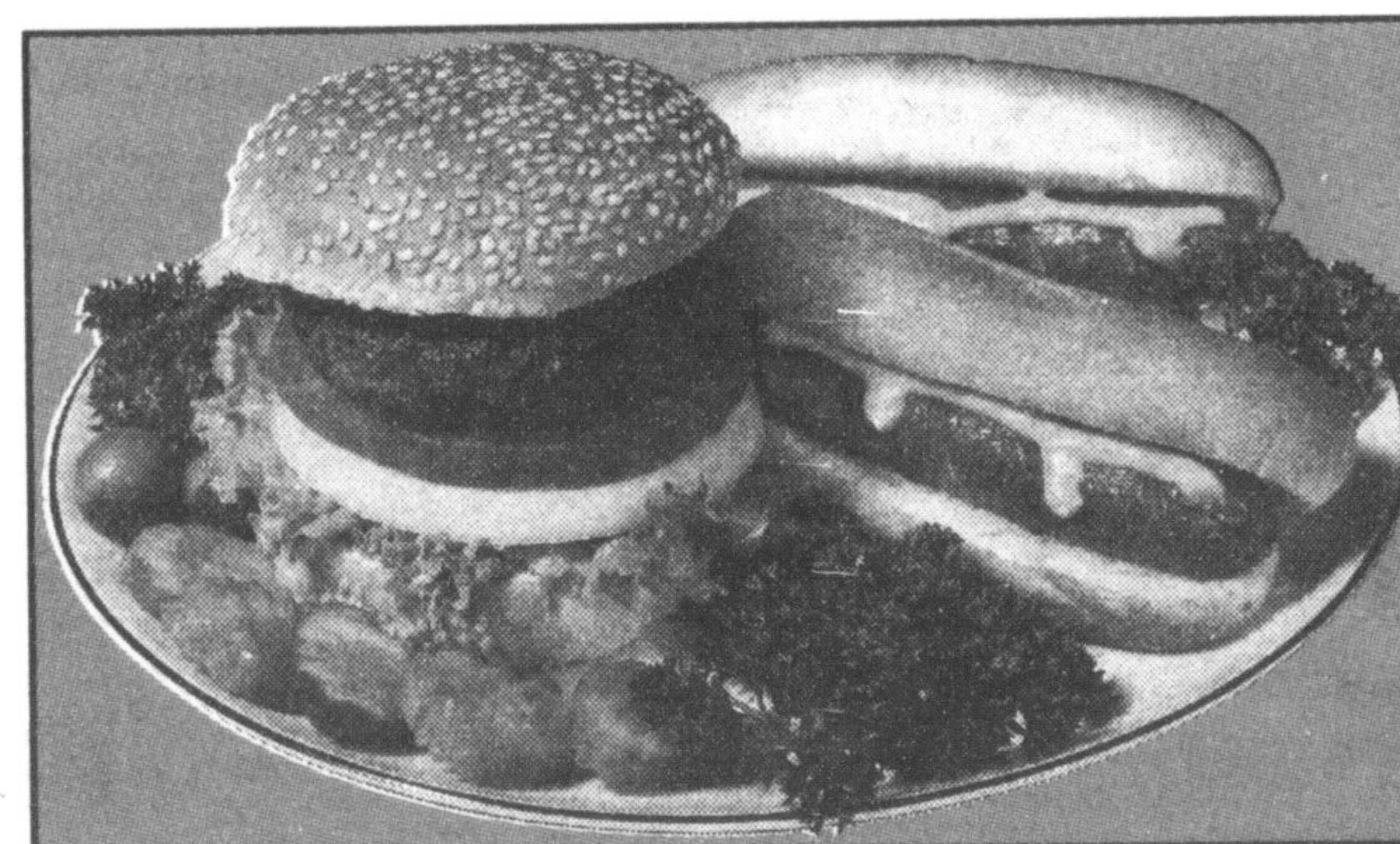
