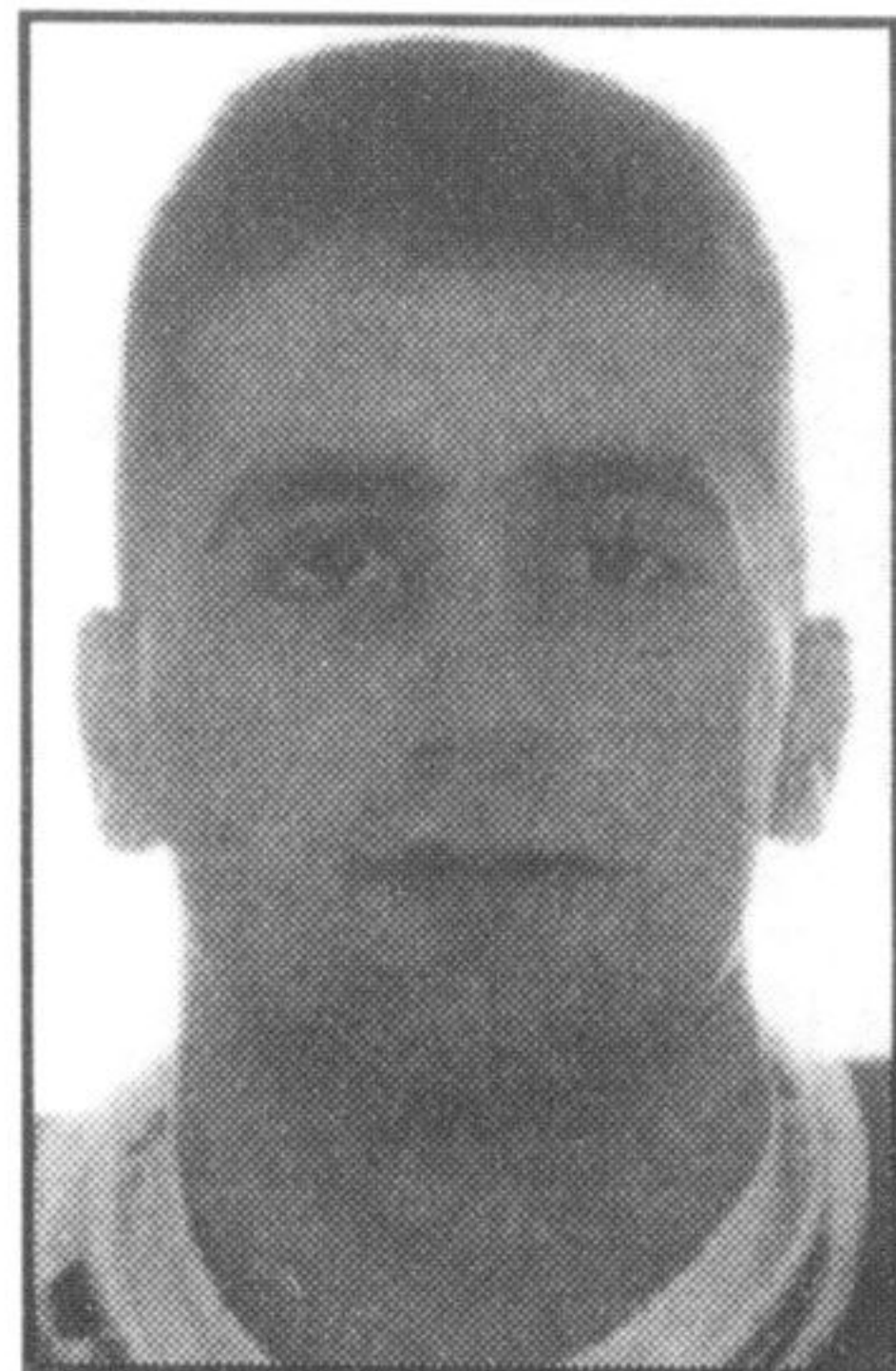
"Mark comes highly recommended by Mike Kelly, who was my assistant at the World Junior tournament the last two years."

He spent one season as a player at Mankato State University in Minnesota

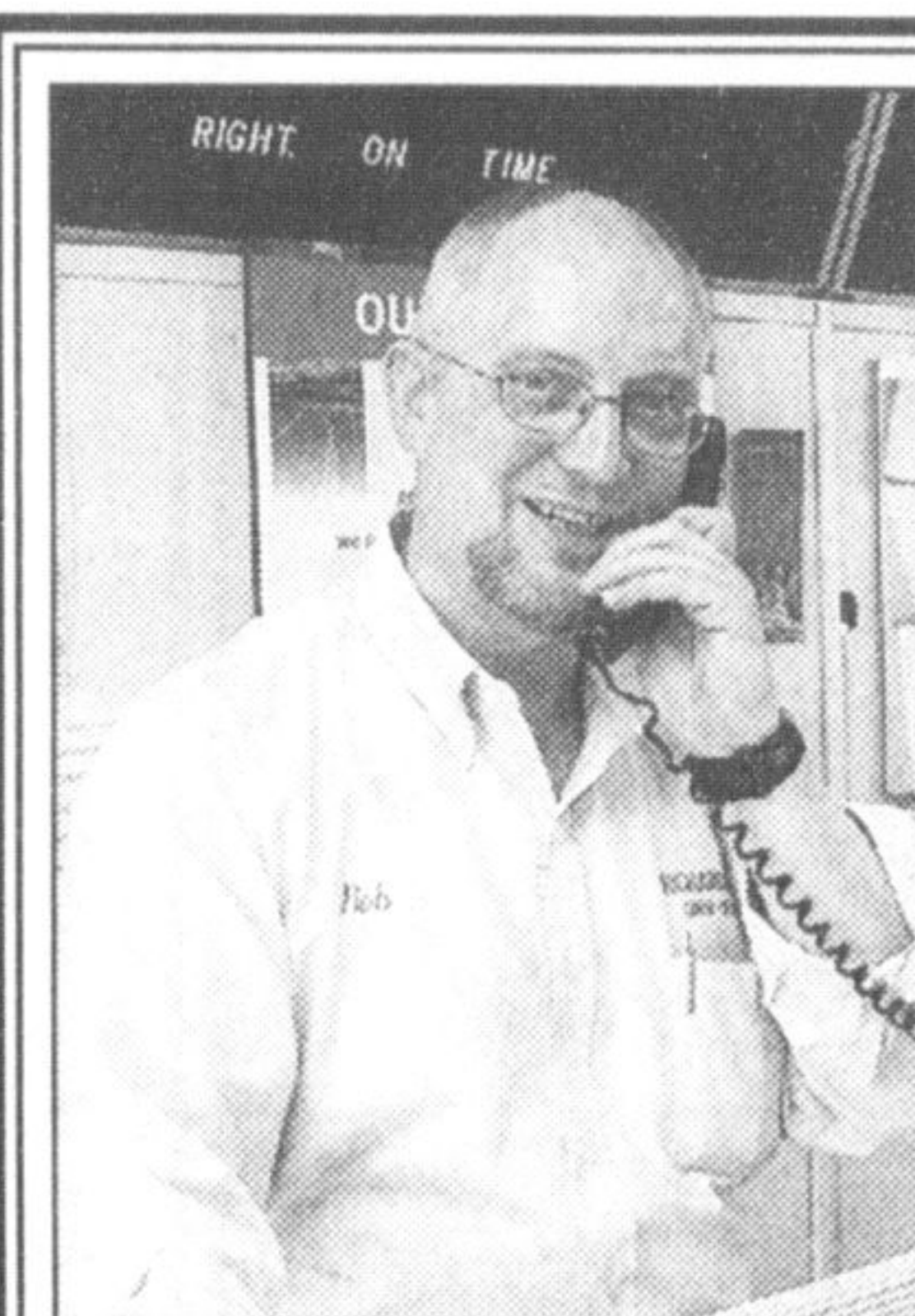
before moving on to play at Brock University. He was the Badgers' head coach in 1997/98 and spent the following season as an assistant at the University of Guelph.
