Debby Rennie helps teach students in Milton how to build their dreams.

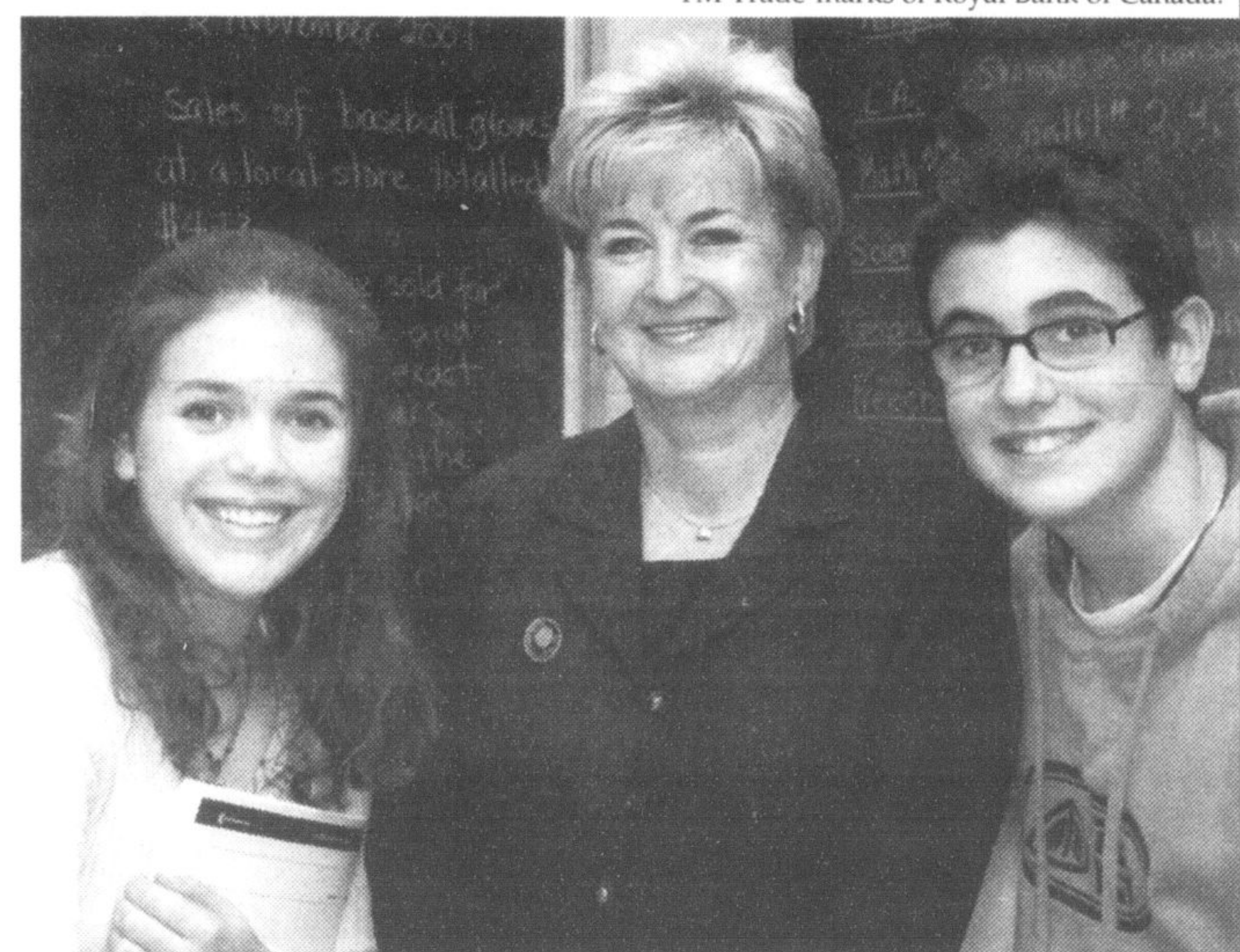
