Community Living Month aimed at bringing more attention to the developmentally disabled

Local support network has been around for almost half a century

ince 1955, Community Living North Halton has serviced persons living with developmental disabilities.

"Our organization provides support and services for people with developmental disabilities and allows them to take their place in the community in whatever way they can," said John F. Bedell, executive director of Community Living North Halton, which includes Milton, Georgetown and Acton.

May is Community Living Month. In recognition, Community Living North Halton held a bike-a-thon in Georgetown earlier this month and will take the group to a Toronto Blue Jays game.

"I don't think people realize intellectually disabled people are lonely," he continued. "Even if a few people have a better understanding of what it's like for them, the better."

Many services available

The organization offers a variety of services, including adult residential assistance and recreational activities with an emphasis on community integration. It also provides resource consultants to pre-school children with special needs and their families and employment opportunities.

"For our residential services, we seek no more than five people whenever possible," Mr. Bedell said, adding the organization prefers the term developmental disability opposed to mental retardation as the latter tends to label people.

Although most people he's run into have no knowledge of what Community Living North Halton is, he said the name better reflects the services offered.

"The name is not well known but hopefully people will come to know it. Some people think it has to do with housing, seniors or physically disabled people."

Mr. Bedell said he believes misconceptions people have about persons with developmental disabilities are due to "fear of the unknown."

"If you don't know, you're fearful. It's a fear factor."
