
## Planting Instructions

You have purchased a healthy living plant. Keep it that way by taking the following steps:

- 1. Upon your arrival at home, place the plant in the shade and keep moist until planted.
- 2. Dig a hole, minimum 30-40 cm larger that the pot, ball or root spread.
- 3. Rough the sides and bottom of the hole to help drainage and root penetration.
- 4. Clay soil: Plant minimum 10-15 cm above the surrounding soil. Backfill with a mixture of topsoil, manure and peat moss.
- 5. Sandy soil: Backfill with a good gardening mix.





- 7. Trees should be staked and tied.
- 8. Spread mulch or compost around the base to keep plants moist. Feed twice yearly at the surface.
- 9. Roses should be planted with the bud (bump on stem), 2" below the surface.
- 10. Water as needed 2-3 times weekly during 1st year.
