## Jr. B Mavericks push their win count to five

When the Jr. B Mavericks begin a home-and-home series with the top-seated Halton Hills Bulldogs Thursday it should be with a newfound sense of purpose.

Milton hosted 2002 Founder's Cup hosts six weeks ago in season-opening play — and at the time, was simply looking to reintroduce local sports fans to lacrosse.

A less than impressive effort was delivered and the end result was a 20-8 pasting for the Mavs.

Since then, the upstart juniors have made significant strides — having won a handful of games to firmly plant themselves in the playoff picture — and will no doubt be eager to prove that against the OLA Mid-West front-runners starting Thursday night at John Tonelli Sports Centre.

The 5-7 Mavericks will be coming off their most hectic week to date - one in which they came heartbreakingly close to a clean sweep.

Milton's three-for-three bid was eventually quashed in overtime in Six Nations Sunday afternoon. The visitors erased a number of leads to force an extra session, where they were one-upped in the goal department and eclipsed 10-9.

Kaegen Sherriff led with a hat-trick while tallying twice were Kyle Goertz, Kyle Hagel and Derek Mewhinney. Josh Arnold was between the pipes while chipping in three assists was Rick Gallinger.

This followed a prosperous two-game home stand in which the Mavericks bolstered their shot at post-season play with high-scoring victories over Guelph (15-11) and Nepean (12-10).

Paul Pedulla stood out both nights — particularly against Guelph Thursday, when he struck for five goals and a pair of assists. Two nights later against Nepean, he capped an eight-goal week with a late marker to help seal the deal.

Saturday's winner tally was deposited by Sherriff — who had multi-goal efforts in all three games last week as is starting to become a threat to score at even strength as well as shorthanded.

Meanwhile, Matt Decaire — one of the more promising youngsters in the local lineup — enjoyed his highest output this season versus Guelph Thursday, with two goals and four assists.

Thursday's game against Halton Hills begins at 8 p.m. The north Halton rivals wrapped up their season series at Gordon Alcott Memorial Arena Sunday at 6 p.m.

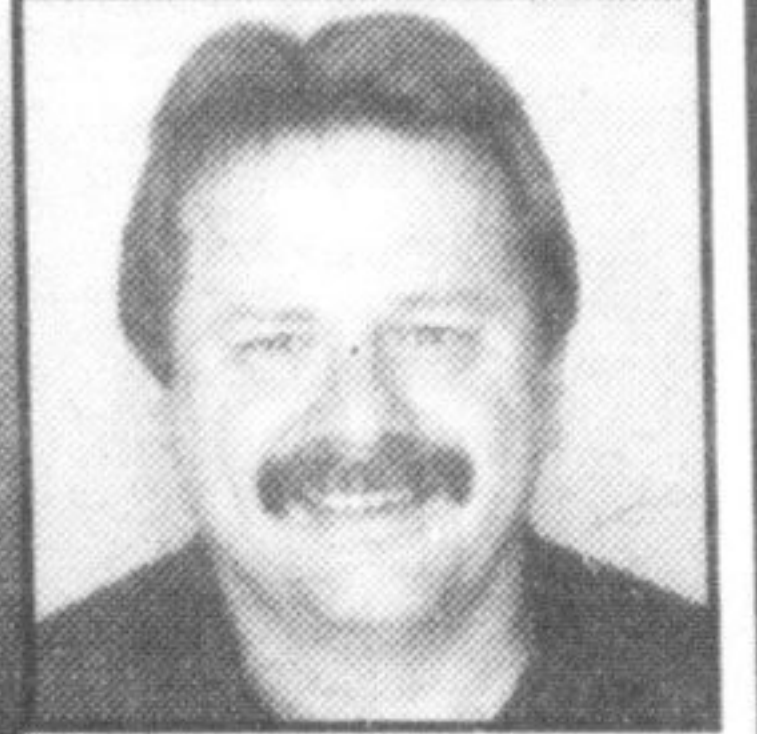
