

CH hires consulting firm to study future needs at Kelso/Glen Eden

With the expected growth of the town over the next several years, Conservation Halton (CH) is making sure Kelso Conservation Area and Glen Eden Ski and Snowboard Centre are well prepared.

At its May 23 meeting, CH's board of directors approved the hiring of consulting firm The Randolph Group to conduct an organization/operations/management

review for Kelso and Glen Eden.

"The purpose of the review is not for cost-cutting or staff reduction," said CH CEO Theresa Maguire-Garber.

"With the growth we will need to increase costs and staff and we want to make sure we are well prepared for the future."

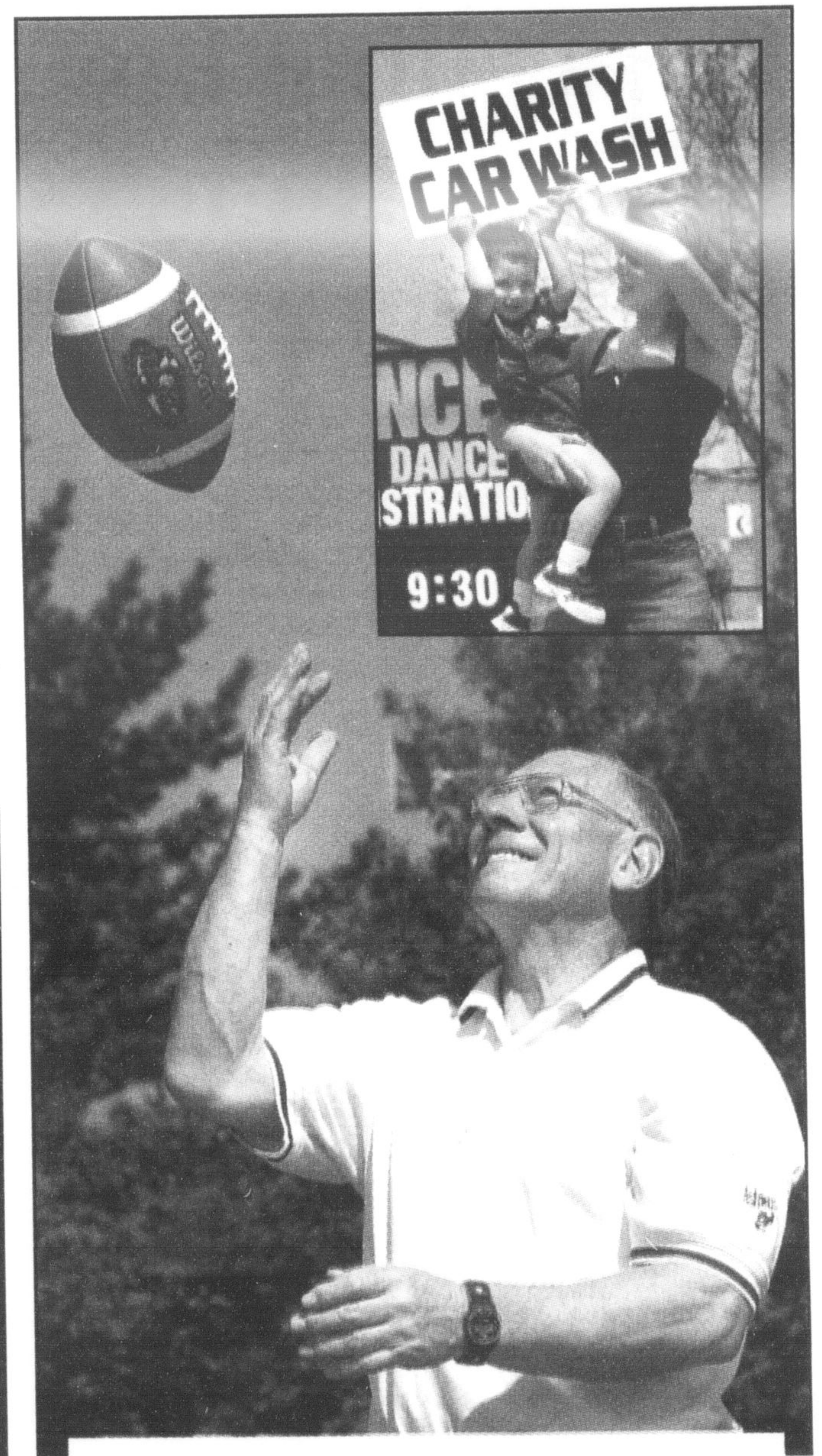
The firm will focus the review, which will cost \$22,500, around full-time staff and managers at the conservation site, additional resources for the future and areas needing work, she said.

"With the growth we will need to hire additional staff, and the review will help us

determine where we will need them," Ms Maguire-Garber continued, adding the review should be completed by mid-July. "If we need additional ski staff, we would need to hire them by the end of the summer."

Although a review of CH's operations was conducted in late 1997, she said this review will focus solely on Glen Eden and Kelso.

"If we don't structure well now, the staff can burn out from the work overload. We have to be prepared for future growth."
