Ms Keech said Friday she was looking forward to the return of the Saturday morning Farmer's Market, which was temporarily set up at Town Hall while construction was underway. It was back downtown Saturday for the street re-opening party.

"Before the street looked like a narrow farm town and now it looks like a thriving small town road."

Lene Oest said she's looking forward to the street getting back to normal.

"I think they did a wonderful job, it looks great," the owner of A Catered Affair said, adding the restaurant did suffer a significant loss of sales during construction. "I'm somewhat impressed by the

size of the trees. We have a beautiful downtown. It looks really sharp."

Nanci Scriver, co-owner of Cypress Intimate Apparel and Bridal Wear, said although she had hoped for more parking spaces, she's content with the new look of the street.

"I like the hanging plants and the posts. The sidewalks really needed replacing."

Like other Main Street businesses, sales at the specialty store were down for about two weeks, Ms Scriver added.



People seem to be pleased with the downtown's new look, however there's a small problem with this pedestrian sign.

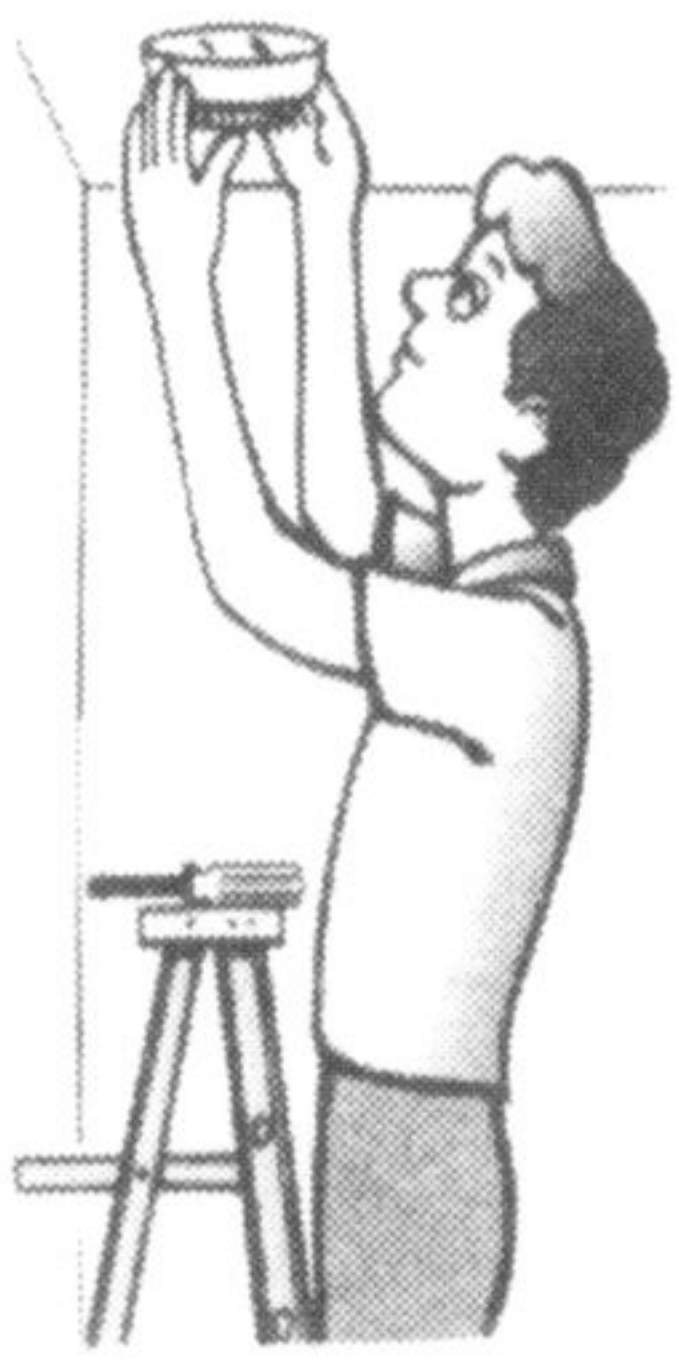
"I'm glad to see they were able to keep the old town feeling after the construction was finished."

The revamped street is phenomenal, according to Keith MacKay, owner of The Fitness Technique. "It has exceeded my expectations. It would have been nice to have bigger trees but they are an appropriate size. Now it's up to us (business owners) to improve the look of our businesses on the outside to match the improvements on the street. It's still Milton but it looks more sophisticated."

The re-construction of Main Street from James to Commercial streets began in March. The re-construction saw the wastewater mains replaced and new servicing connections for the Main Street buildings. The last layer of asphalt was laid Tuesday and traffic lines were re-painted Wednesday, officially completing the re-construction project.
