Sally was at last able to own horses again.

Sally thrived on adventure and excitement:

bringing the horses in during a winter

storm, 'hosting' a fugitive bank robber with

her Akita and climbing to the top of a new

steeply pitched roof to enjoy the view at

age 75. She greatly enjoyed the company

of young people and was rejuvenated by

visits from her grandchildren and great-

grandchildren. Sally continued to live in her

own house until late 1999, when the com-

bination of strokes and a broken hip

required a greater level of care than her

family could provide. Sally was feisty,

independent and proud and it was difficult

to witness the transition to life in a nursing

home, where she was a frail and helpless

patient. She bore the loss of independence

with dignity and with fortunate to have

devoted caregivers. As her strength aban-

doned her, she developed a sweetness

and grace. Sally did not die in a horse barn

with her boots on, as she might have

wished, but she was comfortable and sur-

rounded by those who loved her. Her body


