

# Man attacked by youth at store

A 47-year-old Milton man suffered minor injuries during an altercation outside the Mac's convenience store at White Oaks Plaza July 11.

According to police, the man was about to enter the convenience store at about 3 a.m. when he was asked by a youth if he could buy cigarettes for him.

When the man refused, he was punched and kicked before the youth fled on a bike.

The victim was treated for minor injuries and released a short time later.

The suspect is described as a white male with a shaved head and goatee. He's about six feet tall with a medium build.

## Vehicle theft thwarted

It appears that a routine police patrol at Rattlesnake Point Golf Club is responsible for preventing the theft of a 2000 Honda Civic Tuesday morning.

At about 3 a.m., police came upon the Civic about to exit the club, at which point it stopped and two men fled the vehicle.

The suspects are described as being white males, about 18 to 20 years old. They were both wearing baseball caps at the time of the incident.

## Harness equipment stolen

Harness racing equipment valued at \$5,000 was stolen from Argyle Farms on Guelph Line overnight July 9.

Sometime between 11 p.m. and 6 a.m., unknown suspects gained entry to the horse barn and removed five racing harnesses and five harness bags.

## Complex targeted

Windows at two units of a Nipissing Road complex were smashed early Saturday morning.

Sometime between 4 and 8 a.m., unknown culprits broke windows at the Milton Community Resource Centre and the Pipers' and Pipe Band Society of Ontario. The damage totalled \$450.
