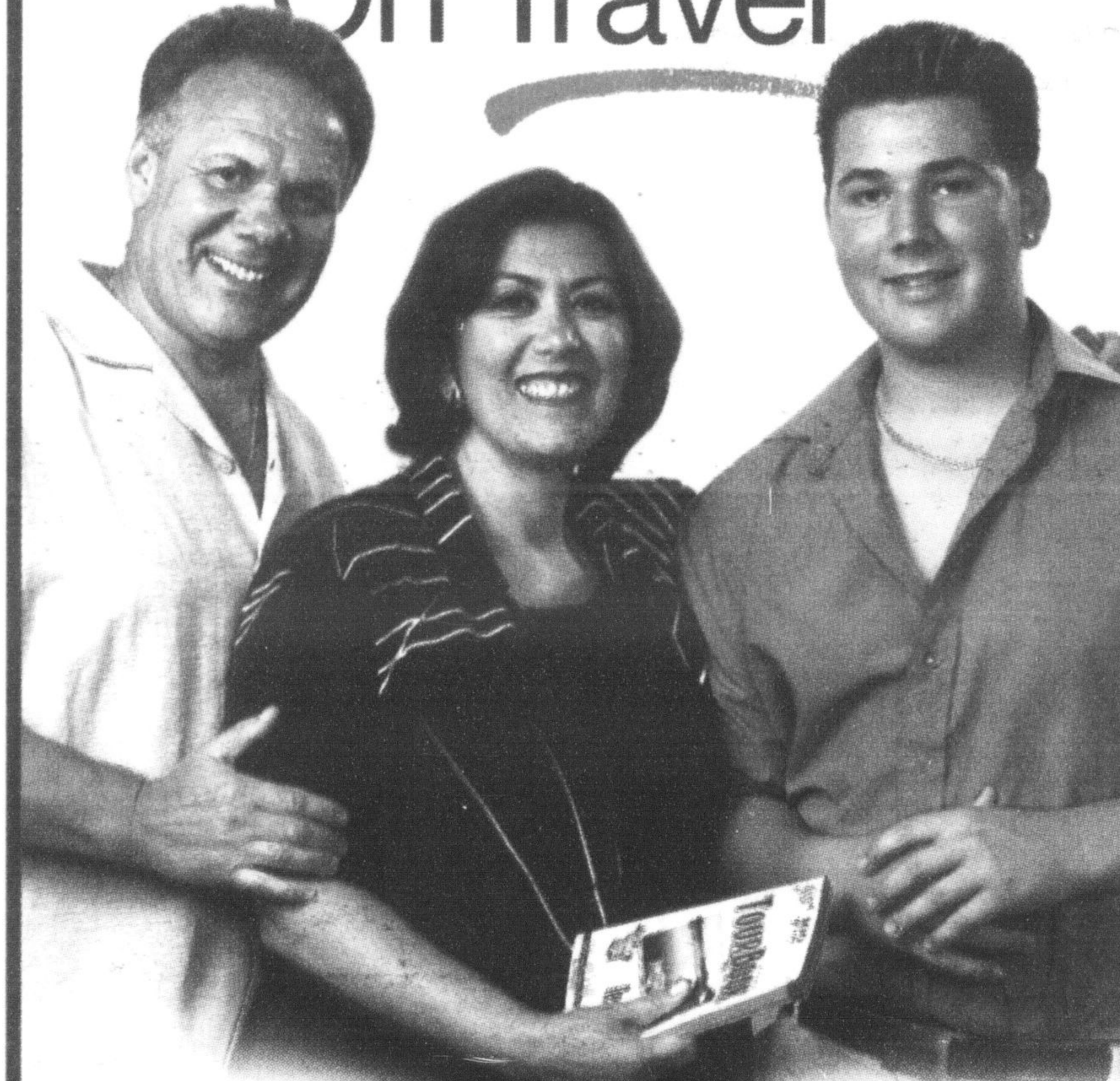
Tickets for the raffle cost \$20 each, or six for \$100.
