Town asking Miltonians to give mementos for scrapbook


Rotary Park's original outdoor pool will soon be gone — but hopefully not forgotten.

Meanwhile, Rotary Park will hold free public swimming for the final two days of its season on Saturday, Aug. 31 and Sunday, Sept.1.




