## No more plastic bags allowed for yard waste

Starting September 1, Halton Region's move to more environmentally-friendly yard waste collection will become mandatory.

This means setting out yard waste such as leaves and clippings in open reusable containers or large paper yard waste bags.

"Residents recognize that this is a good move for the environment and for them as it improves the quality of compost we are able to offer at our popular twice-annual give-a-ways," said Rob Rivers, the Region's director of waste management.

Earlier this summer, Halton residents received a starter kit in the mail, which included a yard waste container label and a coupon for a sample paper yard waste bag. The yard waste bags are also available from local hardware and grocery stores across the region.

This fall's compost give-away will take place from September 23 to October 1 (excluding Sunday) at Halton's Waste Management Site.
