Parking restrictions for fall fair

The restrictions begin today and run through Sunday, in order to accommodate the Milton Fall Fair.

Parking will again be permitted Monday.

Community Fund allocations approved

Town council endorsed the funding applications Monday for Halton Family Services (\$20,000), four Irish dancers (\$500 each) and nine members of A Cappella Showcase (\$224 each).

Council endorses Citizenship Week as well as Waste Reduction Week

Town council endorsed a pair of proclamations Monday night, declaring October 14 to 20 Citizenship Week and October 21 to 27 Waste Reduction Week.

Recognition of Citizenship Week is a national effort requested by the Ministry of Citizenship and Immigration.

The Recycling Council of Ontario requested the Waste Reduction Week designation as a way to promote and celebrate waste reduction.

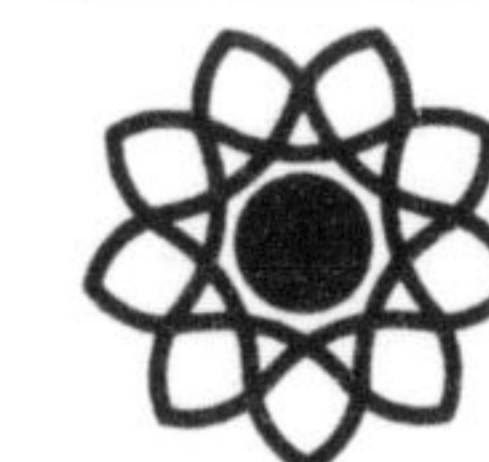
