Halton Region Council invites applications from members of the public who are interested in serving on Halton Region's Official Plan Review Steering Committee. Four volunteers, one from each of Halton's area municipalities - Burlington, Halton Hills, Milton and Oakville, are being sought to serve on the Committee in the capacity of Member-at-large.

The role of the Committee is to provide advice on consultation, to facilitate workshops and focus group meetings, to provide advice on Official Plan directions, and to comment on new policies. The Committee will meet every three weeks for the initial stages of its work, and will continue to meet until Regional Council has considered all proposed amendments to the Regional Official Plan in 2004.
