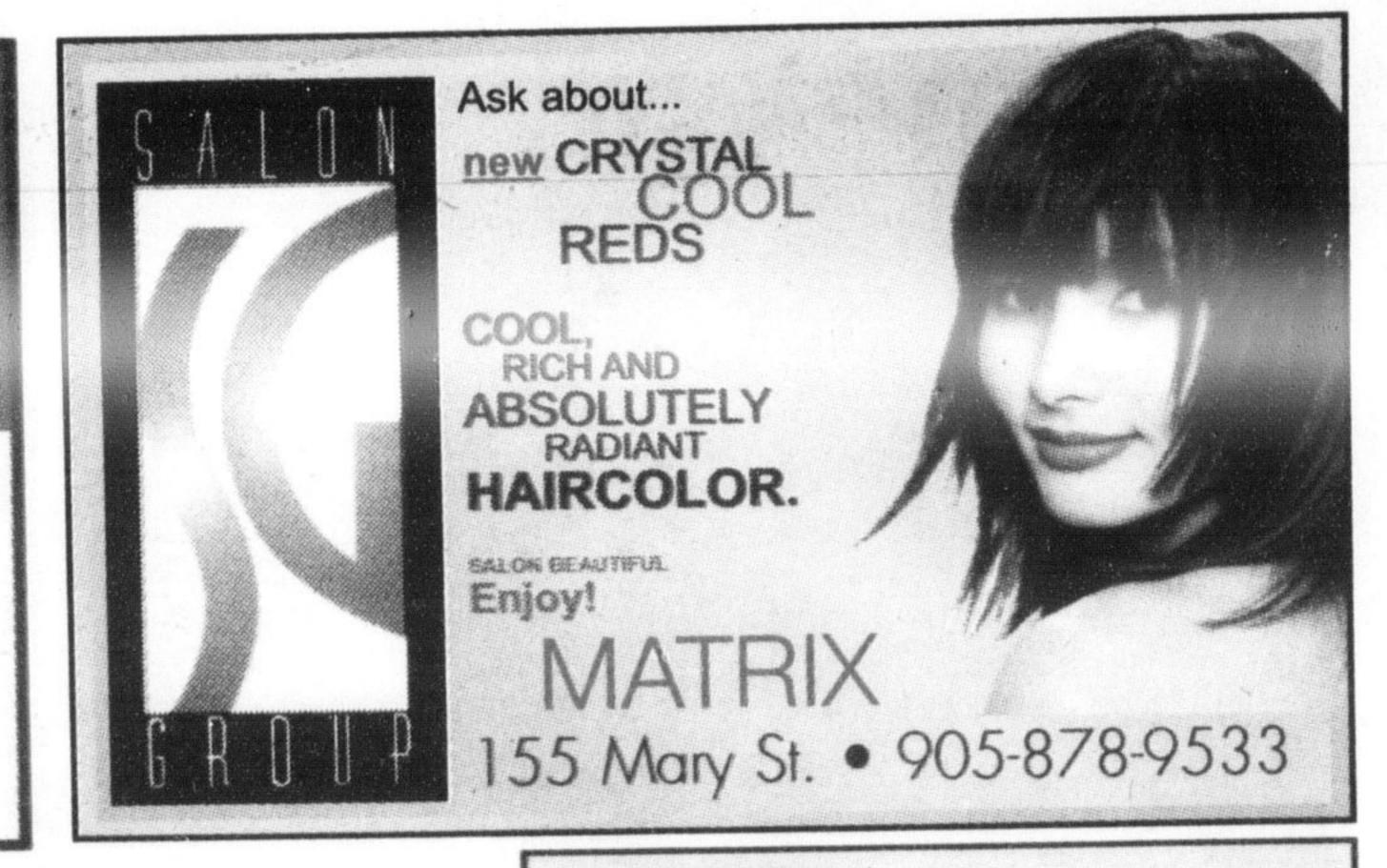

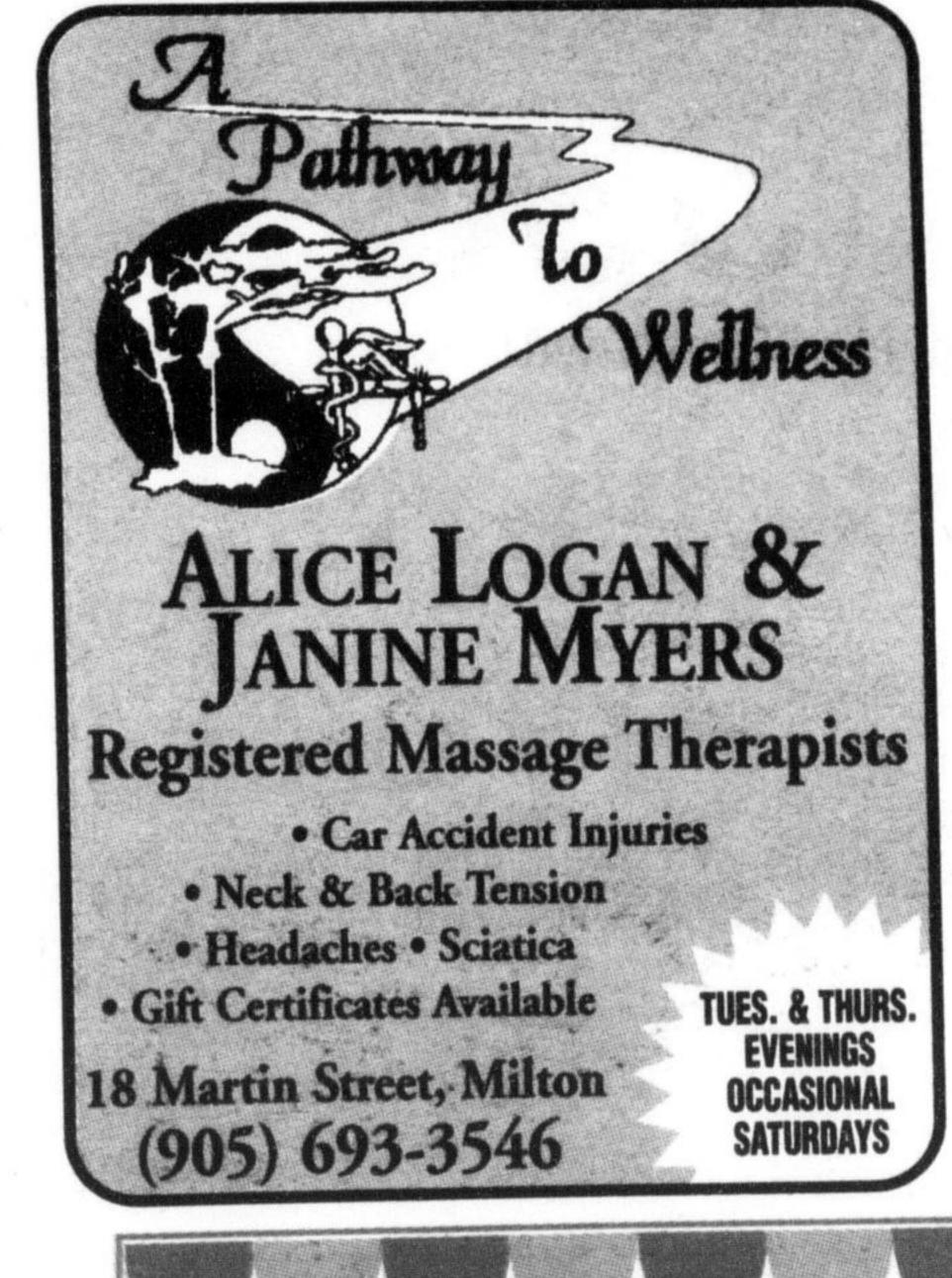

Massage is nothing new. Hippocrates (466-377 B.C.), the founder of modern medicine, said that physicians should be skilled in the art of touch and that massage is essential to the healing and treatment of pain.

Massage therapy is known as hands on healing for good reasons. One of the most popular reasons for seeing a massage therapist is to reduce muscle pain. Systemic soft-tissue manipulation acts on pain receptors, alleviates fluid congestion, increases range of motion and releases trigger points where stress can build.

Acupuncture and massage therapy are used to assist clients in obtaining relief from: motor vehicle accident injuries, whiplash, headaches, back, neck, shoulder tension, repetitive strain, muscle spasms, pregnancy discomforts, and sciatica. Massage pressure is controlled by the

client, so whether you prefer a light or deeper massage, just ask your therapist to adjust the pressure accordingly. Ultimately your body has the capacity to heal itself, but sometimes you need to facilitate your healing process with massage therapy and/or acupuncture.

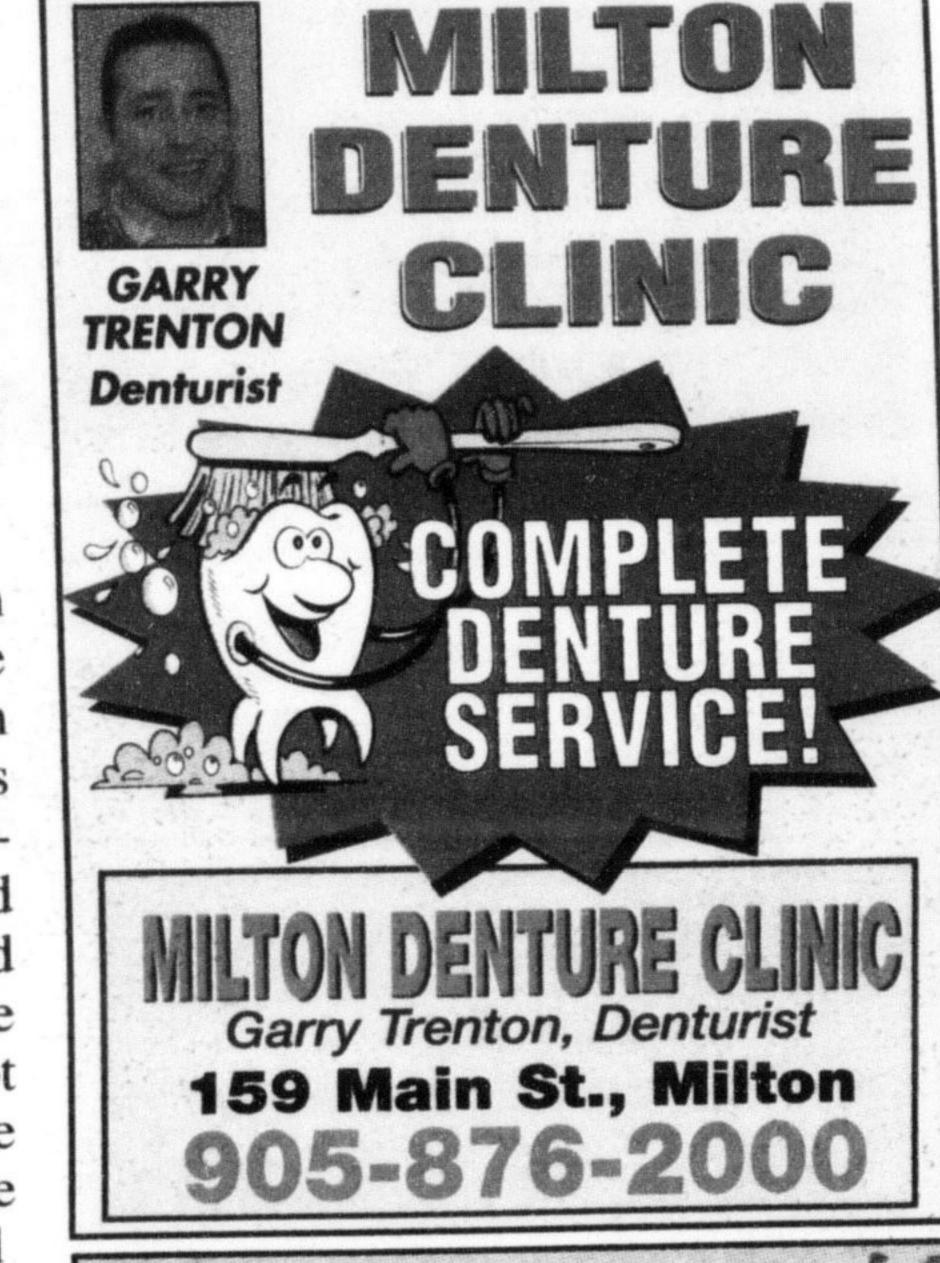
