Golden Hawks finish a disappointing fourth

For most of 2002, Jeff Thomas' golf game has been right on par.

However, the same couldn't be said for season-ending efforts this past week.

of 72 and 71 to secure individual bragging rights. Collectively, Laurier finished a disappointing fourth while McMaster University edged Waterloo for a huge provincial upset.


Thomas was particularly unimpressive on the front nine Monday — recording primarily doubles and bogeys on the way to an overall score of 84. Tuesday's 79-shot effort featured a couple of birdies, but wasn't enough to crack the top-10.

"I just played bad," Thomas said candidly of his year-ending results. "It was the worst two rounds I've shot this year. It was a bad time to play poorly."

A top contender heading into the provincial championships, Laurier was significantly stronger as a whole on day two, although the improvement meant little toward the medal race after finishing 15 strokes back Monday.

A freshman at Laurier, Thomas cracked the six-member team (five players and an alternate) last month and had been a consistent top-10 finisher at every tournament this fall.

This followed a highly memorable junior season, in which he placed second on the Junior Wilson Tour and then guided the top foursome to an Ontario Miller Cup victory in late August at Almonte's Mississippi Golf Club.
