

Jackson is recognized for her service to kids

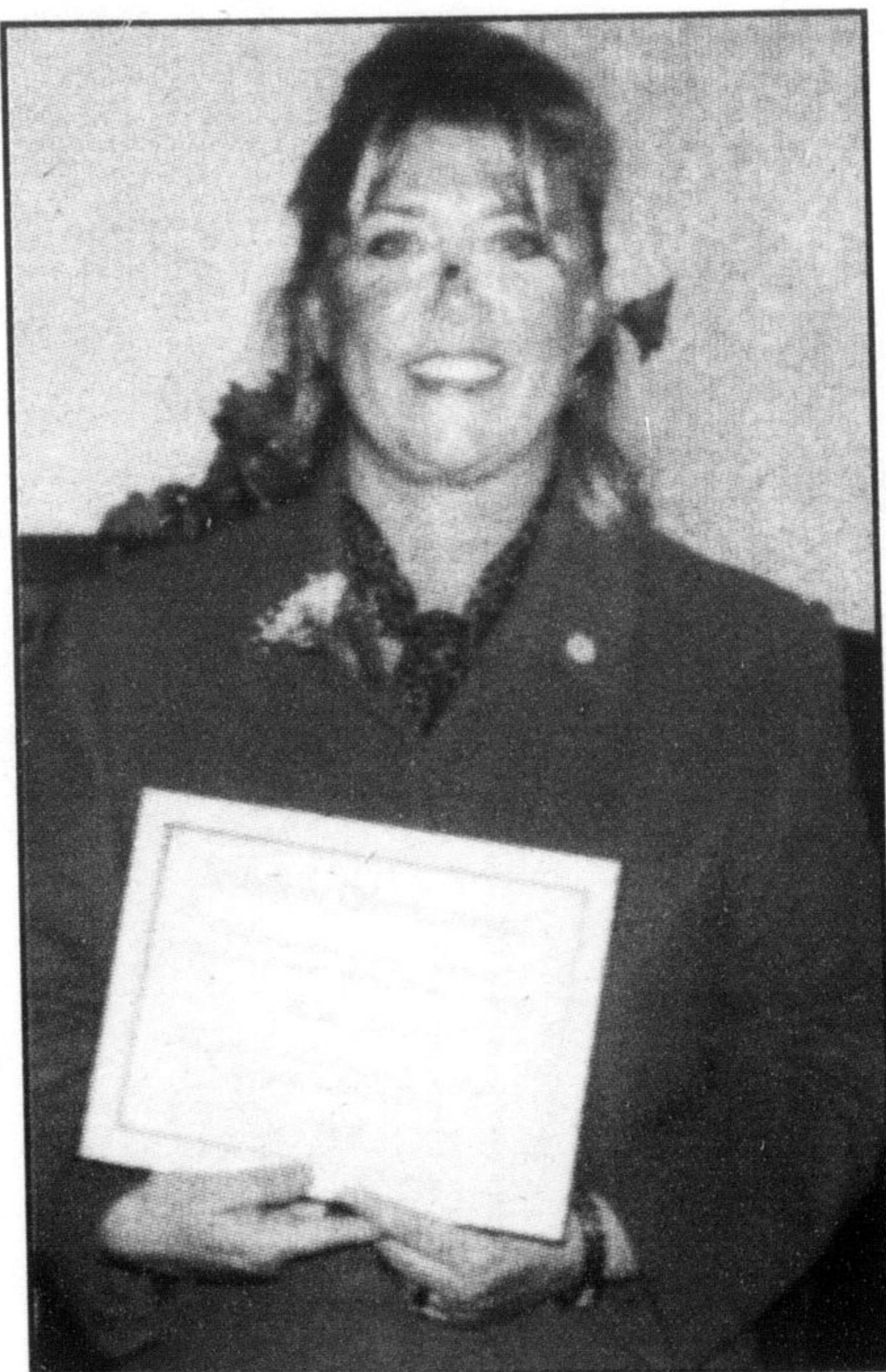
Heather Jackson is committed to the physical and mental development of children.
