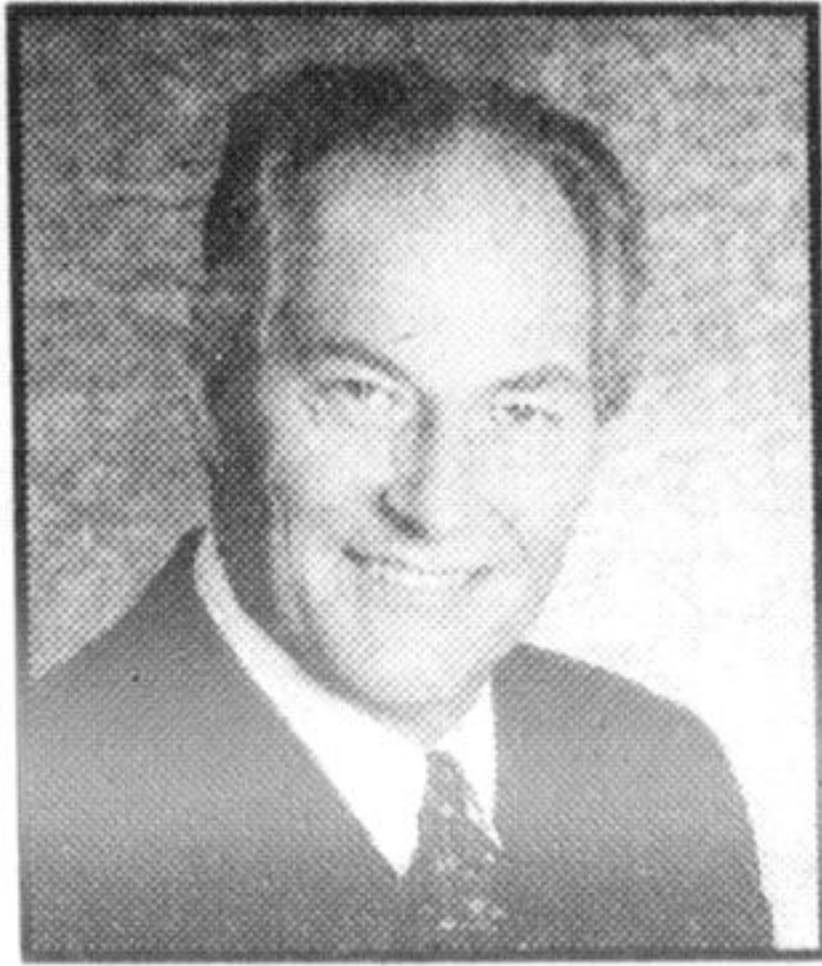
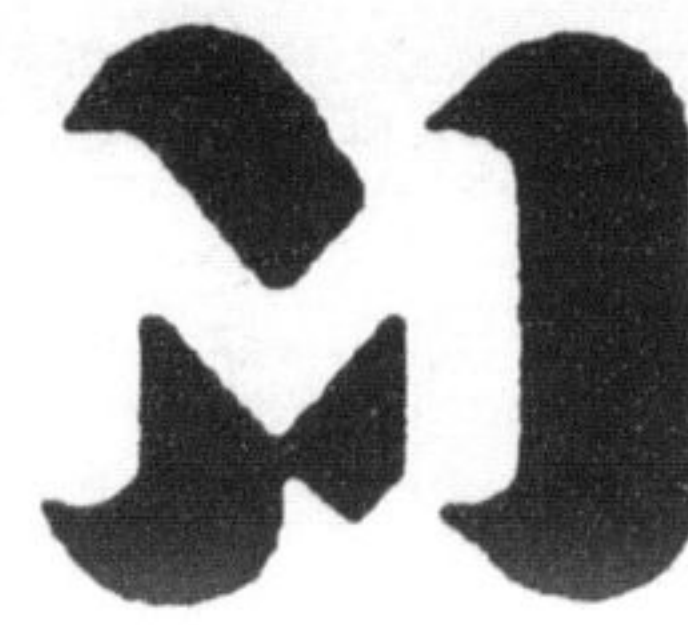

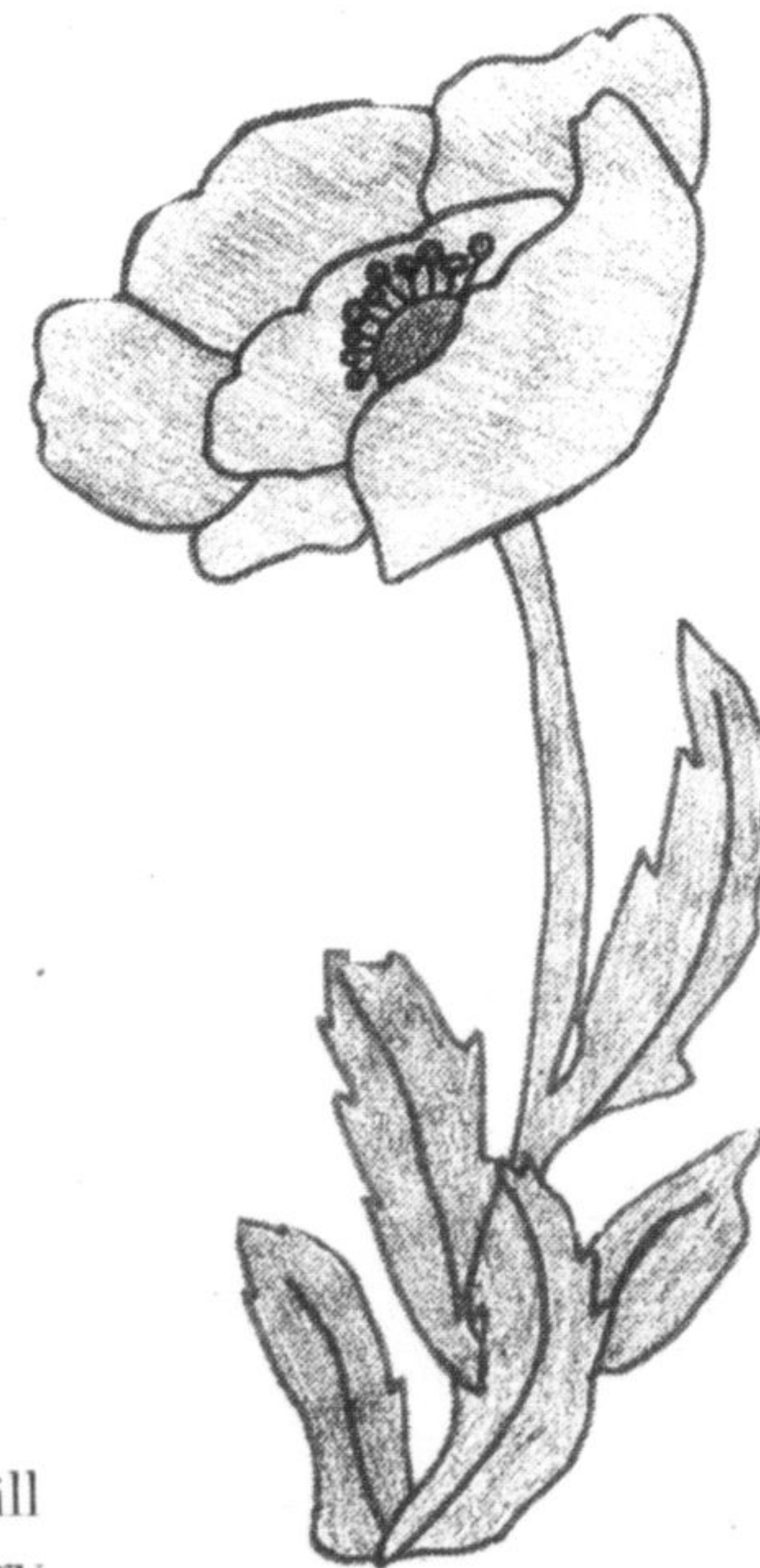

though a soldier died today.

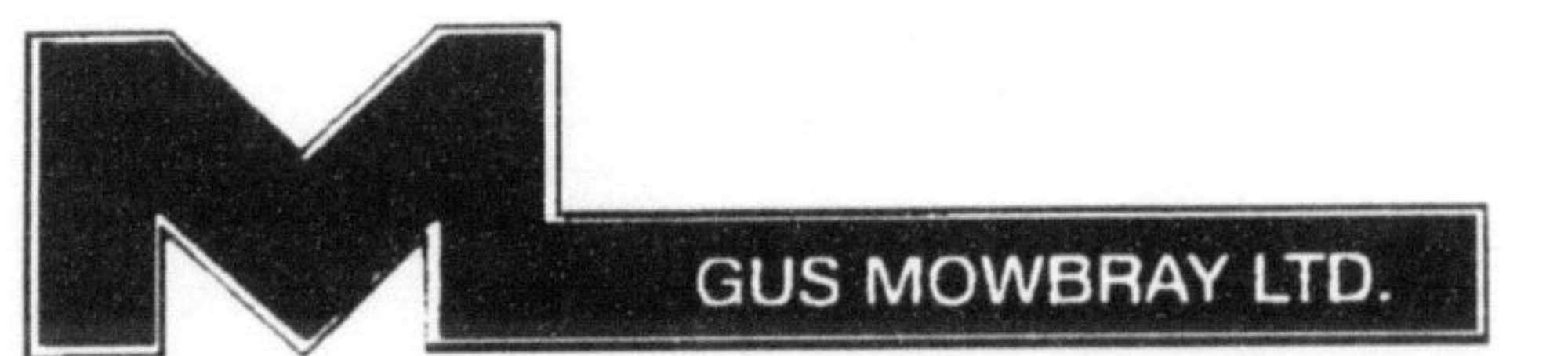
When politicians leave this earth,
