Thieves steal excavator unit from local business

Halton Regional Police are investigating the theft of an excavator unit from Link Line December 5.

Shortly after midnight, unknown suspects cut the lock of the compound gate on Thompson Road.

The suspects moved several vehicles around in the lot and eventually stole a white Ford pick-up truck, a black dual axle trailer and an orange Kubota TX41 excavator that was loaded onto the trailer.

Police located the pick-up truck and trailer the following day near a farm on No. 20 Sideroad.
