

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

Children must be 4 years old by December 31, 2003.

Senior Kindergarten 2003-2004:

Children must be 5 years old by December 31, 2003.

Parents/guardians must be public school supporters.

Please bring the following original documents with you*:

- your child's immunization record
- proof of address
- your child's Ontario Health Card
 proof of your child's age (birth certificate or passport)

*If you are not the child's parent, please bring proof of custody (court order).

To determine your designated home school, you can access our website www.hdsb.ca and go to School Locator (click on "Schools" and "School Attendance Boundaries") or call the Planning Department at (905) 335-3663, 842-3014 or 878-8451, ext. 3240.

Drop by your designated elementary school by February 14, 2003 and register for the Halton District School Board's Junior or Senior Kindergarten program. Please note: parents with children currently attending Junior Kindergarten do not need to reregister for Senior Kindergarten.
