The Milton Public Library is once again inviting children to help select the winners of the Silver Birch Award, which is given annually to two recently-published fiction and non-fiction Canadian children's books.

The program is aimed at readers in grades 4 to 6, although older and younger children are welcome to participate.

After registering at the library's Information Desk, participants will be given a list of the 20 nominated

titles. At least five of these books must be read in order to be eligible to vote, which will take place in May.

The results will then be tabulated from all participating schools and libraries and the winners will be announced in June.

Students in grades 7 to 9 are invited to take part in the Red Maple Award program, also organized by the Ontario Library Association. Procedures are similar to the Silver Birch program, however the award is for fiction writing only.

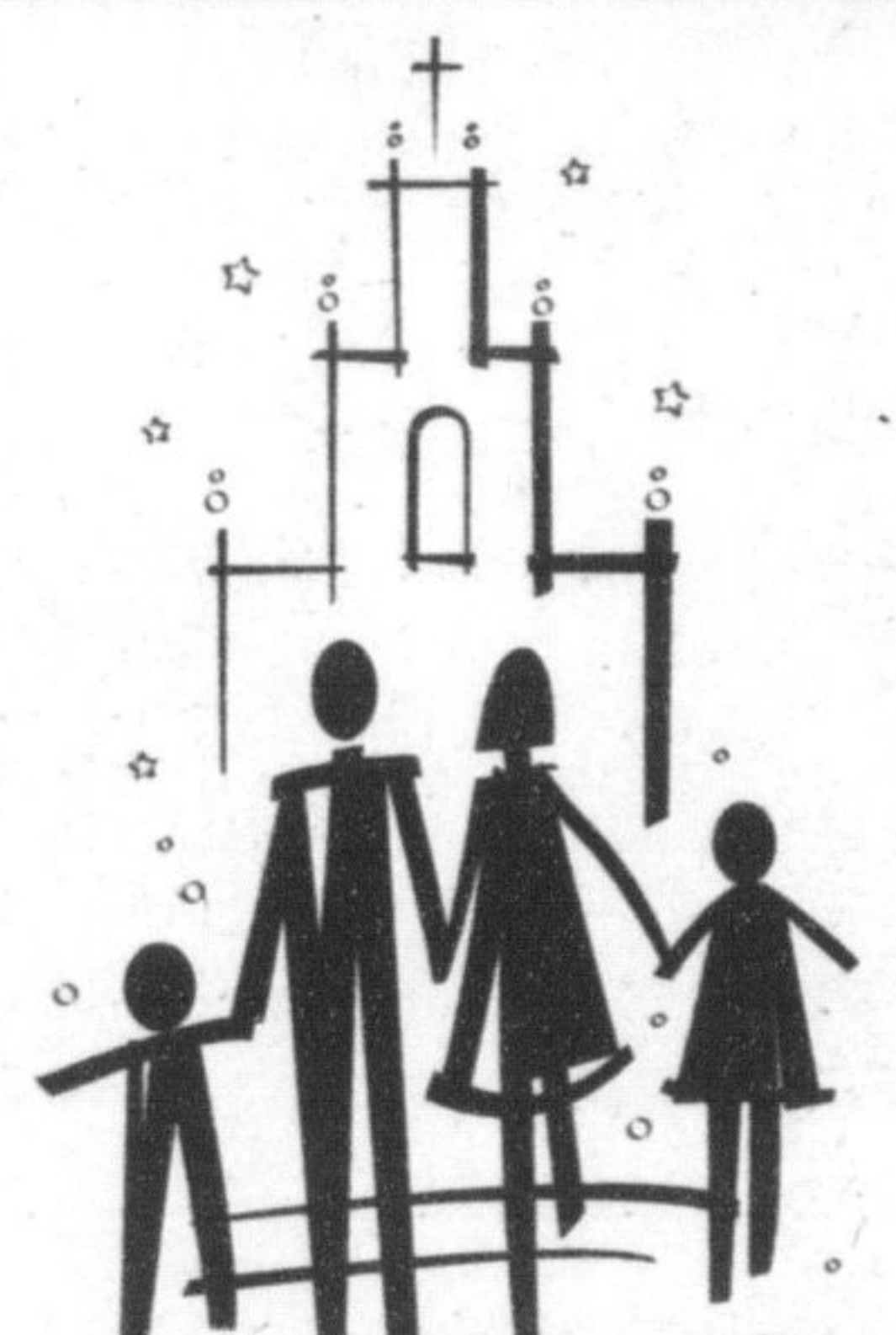

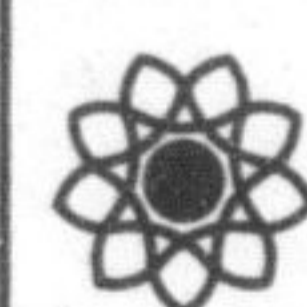
