

# Police search for suspects in attempted car theft

Police are searching for two suspects after an attempted vehicle theft at the A&P plaza at Ontario Street and Derry Road.

A woman parked her 1995 Dodge Caravan to go shopping Monday at 5:15 p.m., and found a suspect in the vehicle when she returned.

The suspect fled and took off with an accomplice who was waiting in a get-away vehicle. The Caravan's ignition had been punched.

The first suspect is described as a white male between 18 and 20 years old with a slim build and short brown hair. He is about 178 cm tall and was wearing blue jeans, an unzipped jacket and a light blue baseball hat. He was carrying a 10-inch screwdriver.

The driver of the get-away vehicle is described as a white male between 18 and 20 years old. He has an average build and short, dark hair. He was

unshaven and wore red sweat pants, a red sweater and a red baseball hat.

### Breath sample refused

An Oakville woman was charged with failing to provide a breath sample Wednesday at Main Street and Hwy. 401.

Police pulled over a motorist at 1:45 a.m. for a traffic violation. While the officer was writing the ticket, the motorist drove away. The driver was stopped once more, and refused to provide a breath sample.

The vehicle, a silver 1993 Dodge Caravan, was taken between 4 and 6:45 p.m.

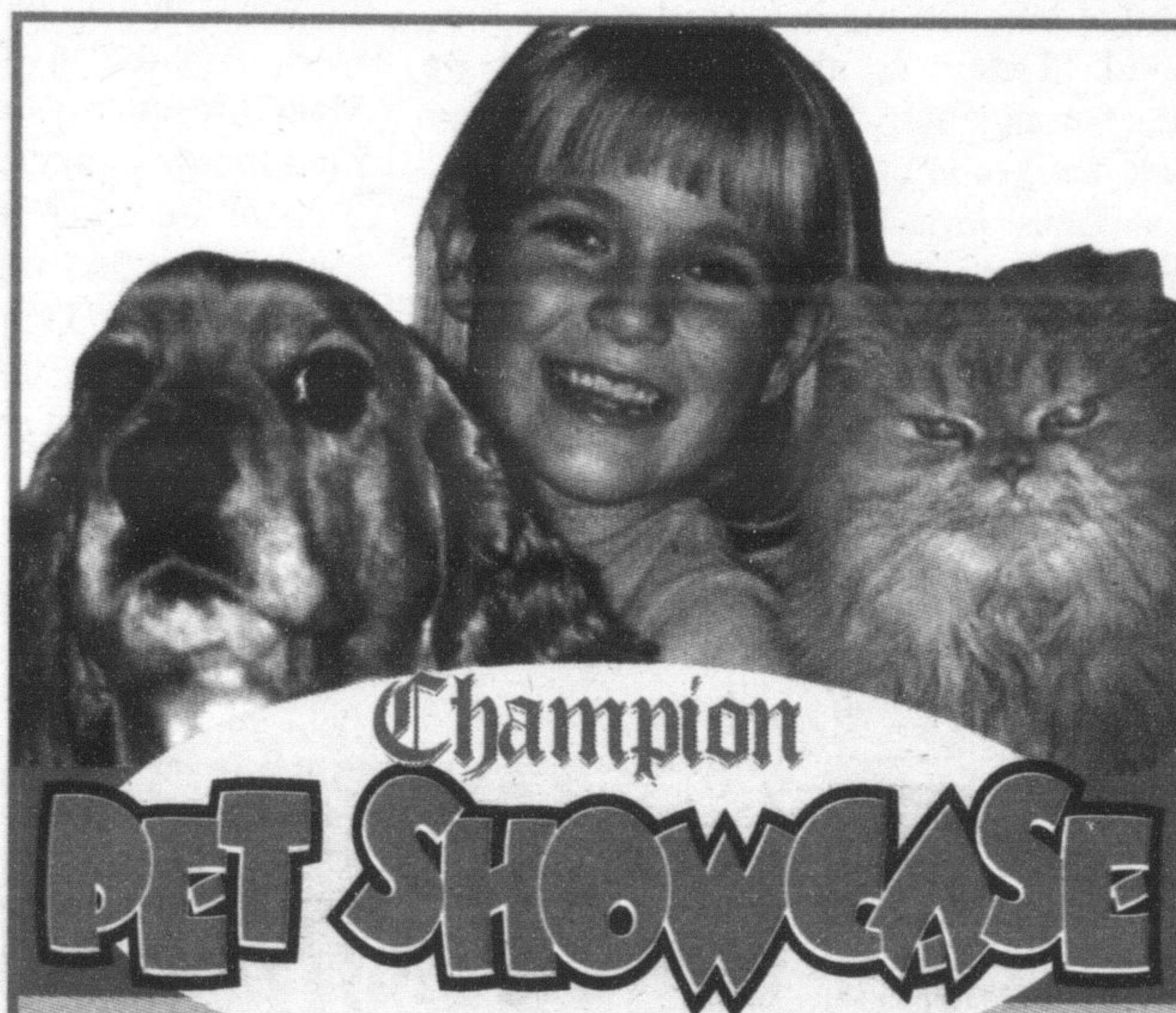
## Crime Stoppers of Halton
