(NC)-If you're looking for a way to woo your sweetheart this Valentine's Day, Anna Olson — host of Food Network Canada's Sugar — suggests impressing your honey by making this easy, decadent chocolate dessert with a raspberry "heart".

Raspberry Molten Cakes:

- Preheat oven to 375°F.
- Melt 8 oz bittersweet chocolate over a pot of simmering water.
- In a separate bowl cream together 1/2 cup of butter and 2/3 cup of sugar.
- Add 3 room temperature eggs one at a time, mixing well after each addition.
- Stir in melted chocolate, 2 tbsp. of brandy or raspberry liqueur and 1 tsp. vanilla.
- In a separate bowl, sift together 1/4 cup all-purpose flour, 1/4 cup cocoa powder and dash of salt. Stir flour mixture into chocolate mixture.
 - Spoon batter into 6 but-


tered ramekins, coated with

- Place a few fresh raspberries into the centre of each ramekin, and gently press in slightly. Bake for 20-22 minutes.
- Run a knife around the edge of the cakes to loosen and tip out.
- remaining Serve with berries.
