## Tedious police search results in two arrests

Police tracked down two breakin suspects following a long, frigid search through fields and bush early Wednesday morning.

The ordeal began after police were called to an alarm at Cristello's Foodland on Crawford Crescent in Campbellville at 2:20 a.m.

One of the responding officers, Const. Doug Williamson, was patrolling through the area when he observed a suspicious van. The van sped southbound on Guelph Line at a high rate of speed and he obtained a licence plate number. Police soon determined the van had been stolen from Waterloo.

After a further search, police found the van abandoned at Derry Road and Guelph Line. Inside were cartons of cigarettes that had been stolen from Cristello's Foodland.

Canine officers from Halton and Hamilton were called in and a foot search for the suspects began.

A track led police to the area of Kilbride Street near McNiven Road in north Burlington, where it was determined another van had been stolen.

Police then found the van a short distance away and two suspects fled in different directions.

The police dog and handler continued and at 4:20 a.m., one suspect was located in dense bush north of Kilbride Street.

"It was awkward terrain, with fields,


snow-covered creeks and ice," said Const. Lisa Scott of the Canine Unit.


The search, which also involved tactical officers, continued through fields and bush and just after 7 a.m., a second suspect was arrested at Walkers Line and Derry Road.


In total, about 15 officers, including those from Oakville and Burlington, were involved in the search. It was the second break-in at Cristello's in two weeks.

Charged were a 39-year-old man and a 30-year-old woman, both of no fixed address. Both were charged with one count each of possession of stolen property; possession of burglary tools; break, enter and theft; and breach of recognizance. The woman was also charged with breach of probation and obstructing police.
