

'A' major peewees drop straight games to Georgetown

Milton's A major peewees were behind the proverbial eight ball heading into game three of their OMHA quarterfinal series with Georgetown last night.

The Liebert Canada Winterhawks were facing elimination after dropping straight decisions late last week — including Saturday's 2-0 whitewash at Memorial Arena.

Milton was restricted to a mere seven shots on net, and as such was simply unable to mount enough pressure. Parker Mott's 17-save performance kept things interesting the entire game.

Georgetown's two goals were both scored late in the second period.

The Winterhawks held the upper hand in terms of shots on net two nights earlier in Georgetown,

but were trimmed 3-2.

Like Mott, John Forcier stood tall between the pipes.

Milton's marksmen were Jonathan Riding and Eric Gottwald, while Matt Jessup provided exceptional defense. A brief breakdown led to two goals against — and essentially cost the local lads the series opener.

If necessary, game four will be played at Memorial Arena February 20 at 7 p.m.

The A peewees did salvage the weekend with a 4-1 victory over Ancaster in Tri County playoff action. Daniel Lewandowski tallied twice, while singles were chipped in by Jessup and Riley Duke.

John Grant and Jordan Haggart each drew two

Forcier stopped seven of eight shots for the win — enjoying ample support from Cal Wollaston.

Midgets tie one on

Milton's A midgets eked one point closer to a second-round win over Georgetown Monday evening — tying the neighbouring Raiders 2-2.

This marked the first on-ice blemish (not including two defaulted games) to the Action

Utility Trailers Winterhawks' league record — which was a perfect 29-0 heading into the night.

Milton took nine minor penalties through the first two periods, and as a result enjoyed little in the way of momentum. Captain Kyle Strong and Ian Komack delivered dynamite penalty killing to minimize the damage, while knotting things up early in the final frame was Dan Lynch.

John Murphy and Derek Blanchard assisted on the equalizer.

Also lighting the lamp was Chris Whiting, with help from Tim Anderson and Jesse Cabral.

Shots were even at 32 apiece. The six-point series continued last night in Milton, with game four being played in Georgetown Monday evening.

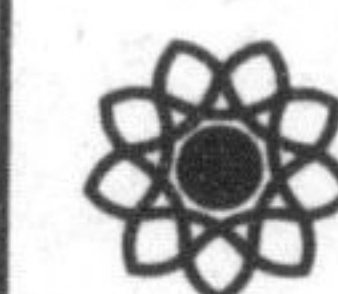
