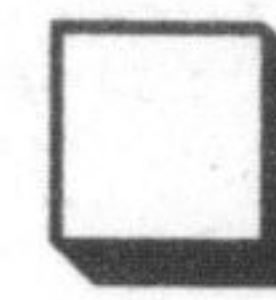
BARBARA BURTON
