It's been a long winter!!! Viral illnesses continue to be evident in our community. According to our Infection Control Clinician, Shirley Lanza, "the potential for communicable disease transmission increases in a setting where people gather. Hospital patients may be at an increased risk."

With this in mind we are asking you to consider the following when visiting patients at Milton District Hospital:

- Come to the Hospital for essential visits only.
- Do not visit any patients if you have any cold-like symptoms or gastro-intestinal symptoms.
- Wash your hands thoroughly before and after your visit.
- Visit only the person you came to see – visiting more than one person increases the risk of spreading germs.
- Watch for signs or any communications when you arrive at the Hospital restricting access to any area.


HAPPY 5TH BIRTHDAY LA TOSCANA!
