Rev. Bob Hyde was well-recognized around town from 1987 to 1999, when he served as minister at St. Paul's United Church on Main Street.

He then moved to Trinity United Church in Kitchener, where he has been since.

Last fall, Rev. Hyde was diagnosed with A.L.S., otherwise known as Lou Gehrig's disease. Trinity United Church is now inviting Rev. Hyde's Milton friends to participate in a celebration of his 31 years so far in the ministry. Friends of his wife, Carol, and sons Jeremy and Andrew are also invited.

The celebration will be held March 30 at 3 p.m. at Trinity United Church, 74 Frederick St., in Kitchener. At this event, attendees will have an opportunity to help create a bursary fund at the Francis Sandy Theological Centre (FSTC).

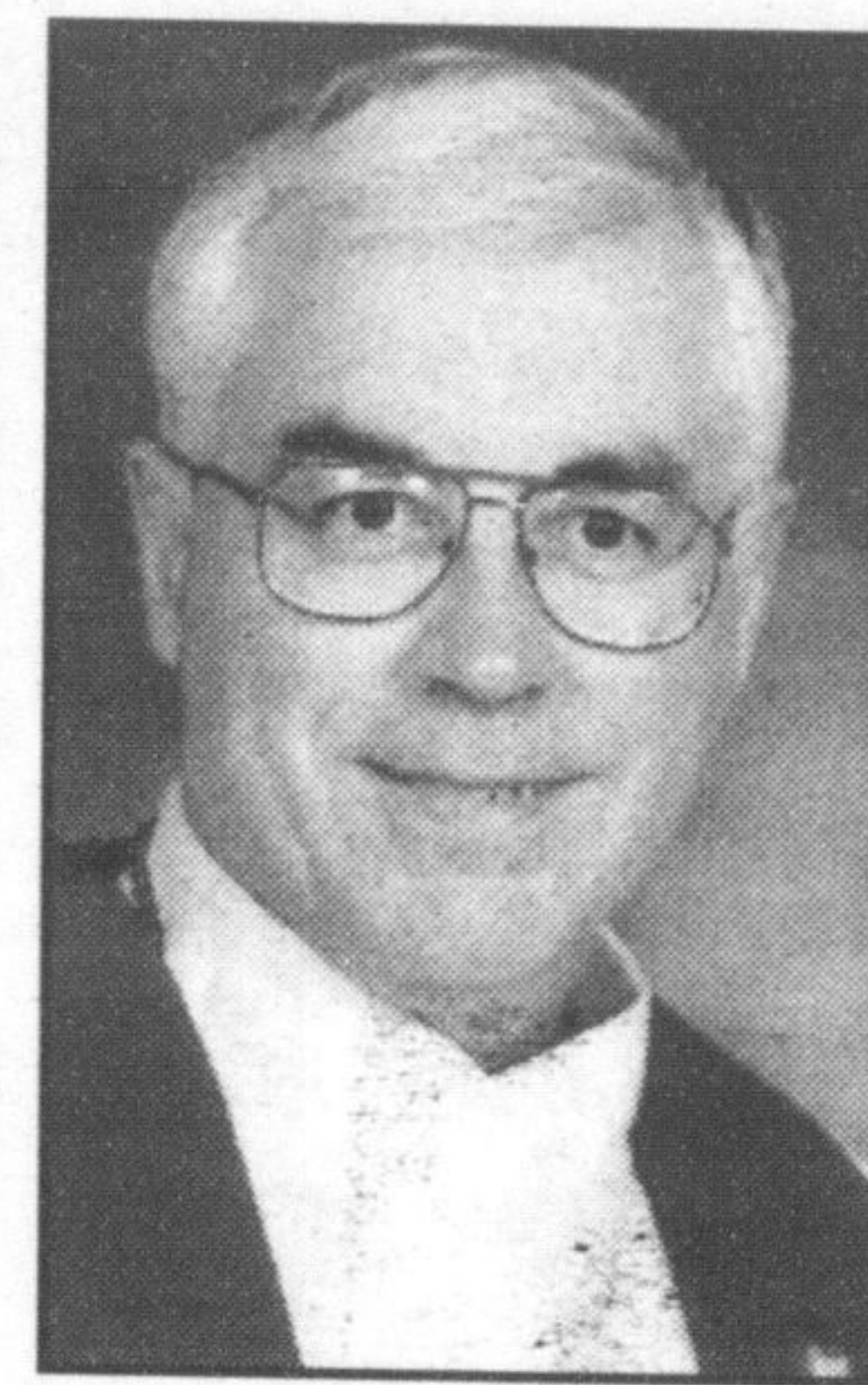
This fund will assist native students as they prepare for ministry and leadership

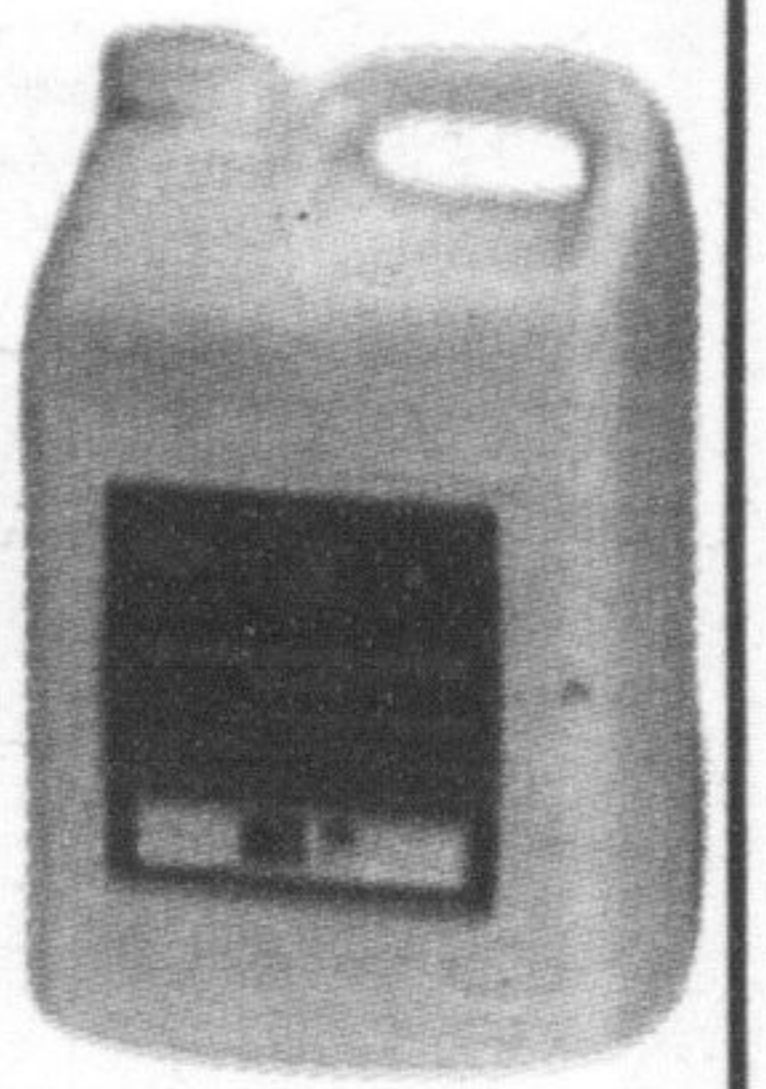

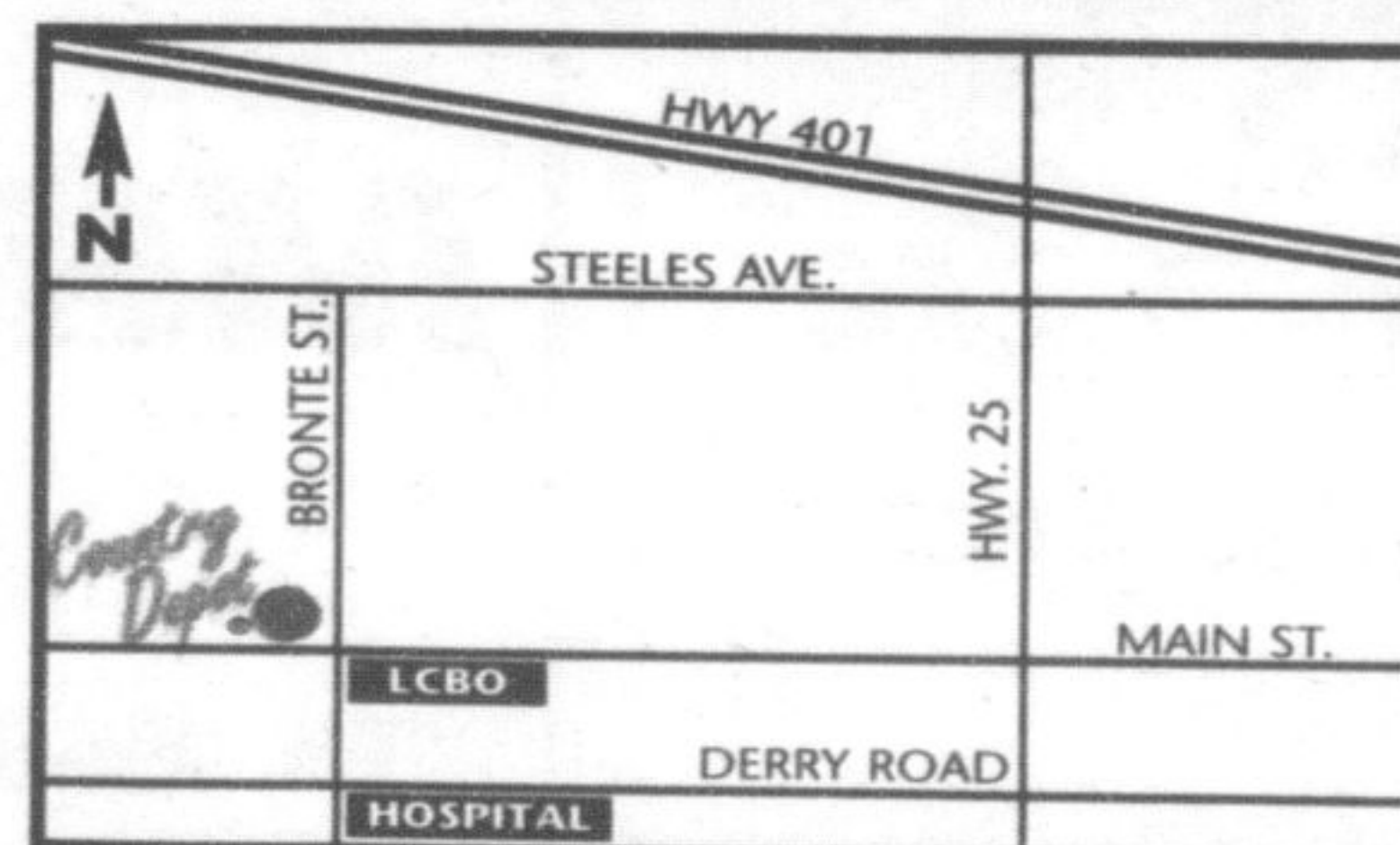
