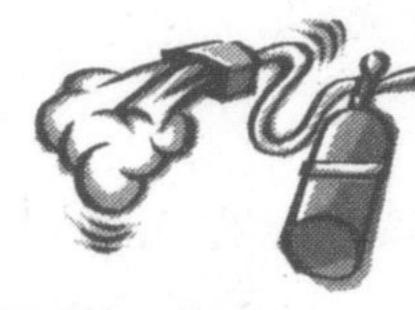


Pub Night Saturday, April 5th

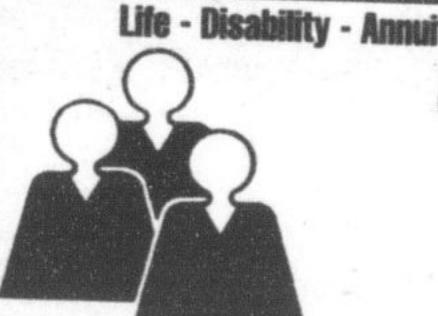
